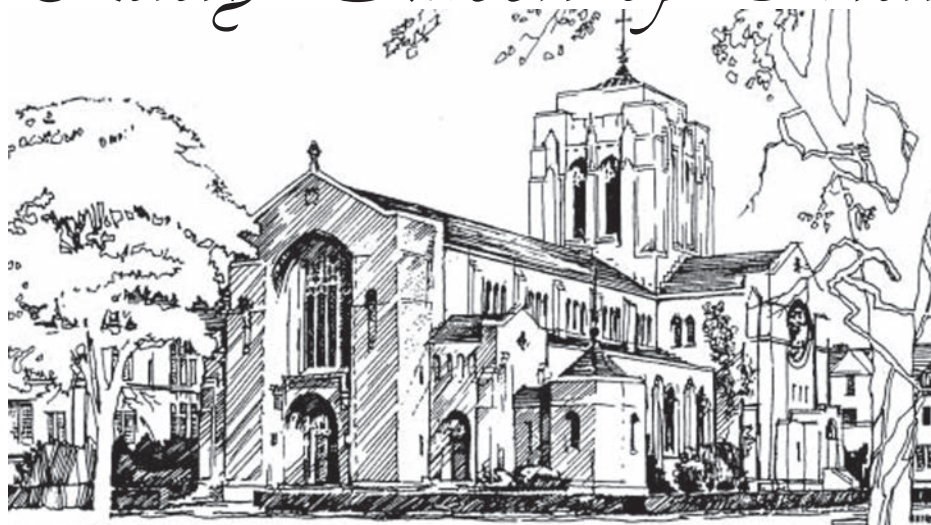

### St. Pio of Pietrelcina, Pray for Us

St. Pio, best known as “Padre Pio,” prayed a Rosary and the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus daily. He lived the Franciscan life of poverty and saw the image of Christ in the poor, the suffering, the sick. Saint Pope John Paul II canonized him in 2002. 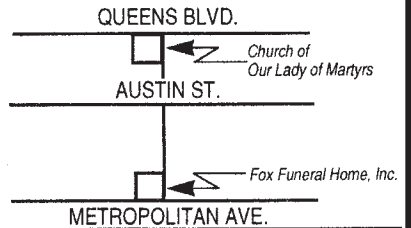
