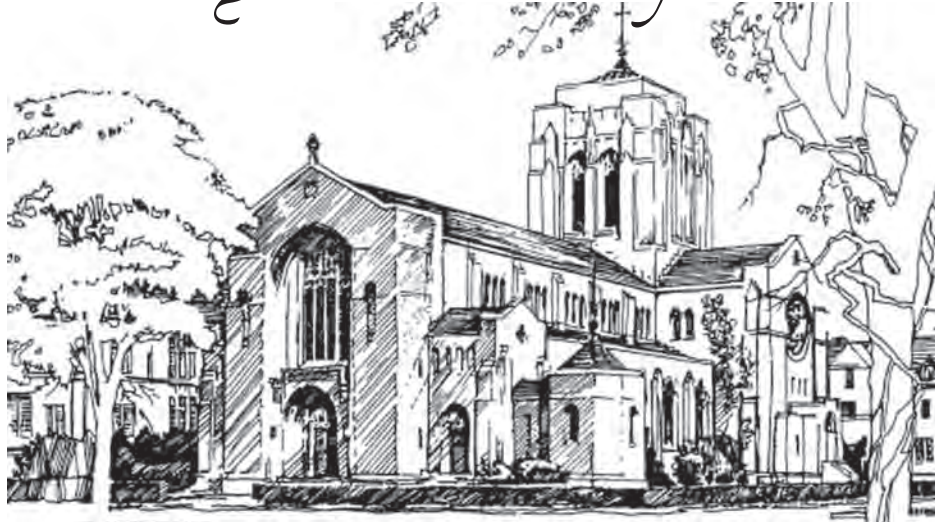

NOVENA to St. Pio of Pietrelcina: January 14 through January 22

Saturdays and weekdays after the 12:05 p.m. daily Mass; Sundays January 15th and 22nd at the 11:30 a.m. Mass

St. Pio, known as “Padre Pio,” prayed the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus daily. He lived the Franciscan life of poverty and saw the image of Christ in the poor, the suffering, the sick. Saint Pope John Paul II canonized him in 2002. Padre Pio prayer groups are spread throughout the world. Our parish prayer group meets the second Wednesday of the month after the 12:05 p.m. Mass.

Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, together with Our Lord Jesus Christ, you’ve been able to withstand the temptations of the devil. You suffered the beatings and the oppression of the demon of hell, who wanted to have you abandon your journey of holiness. We beg you to pray for us so that, with your help and the help of all of the Heavenly Kingdom, we will be able to find the strength to set sin aside and to persevere in our faith until the day of our death.

PRAYER TO THE SACRED HEART: O my Jesus, You have said: “Truly I say to you, if you ask anything of my Father in my Mighty Name, He will give it to you.” Behold, in Your Name I ask the Father for the grace of *(name your request)*. *Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.* Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You. AMEN.

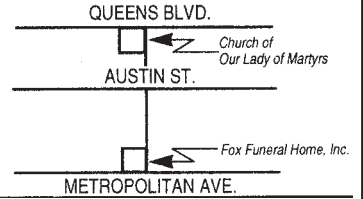
