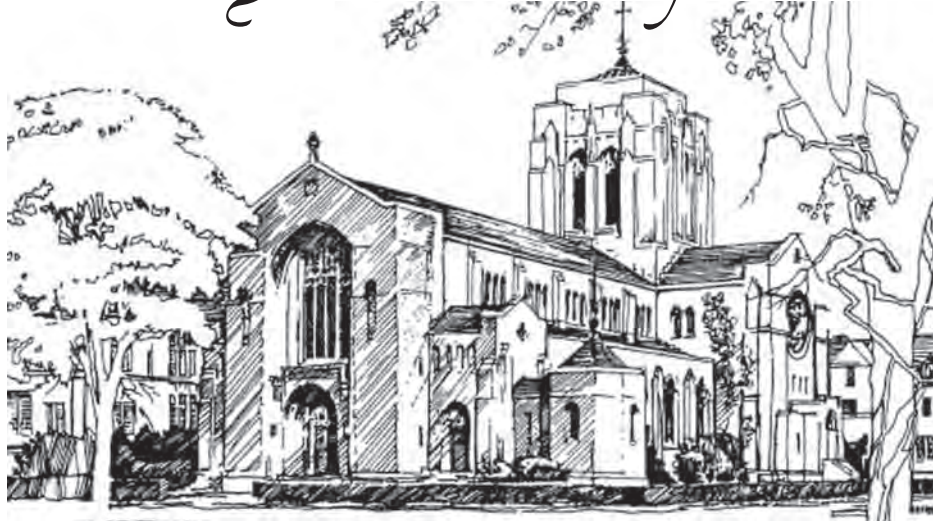

Wednesday, February 11 ~ World Day of the Sick

Healing through Anointing with Oil at the 12:05 p.m. Mass

Join us to be anointed and to pray for those who are sick.

Once a year, on the observance of World Day of the Sick and the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, our parish offers an opportunity for the reception of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick during Mass.

An anointing is a ceremonial action performed by the Church. Through anointing, a person obtains the benefit of divine grace. The Church uses three oils for anointing: the oil of chrism, the oil of catechumens and the oil of the sick. The anointing with oil of the sick is used to support those who seek healing. It can be requested by anyone seeking healing of body, mind or spirit.

Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint (him) with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven.

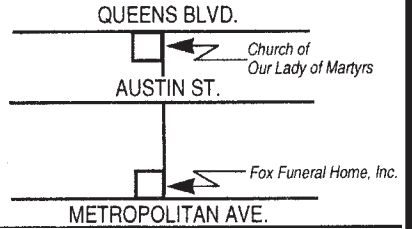
