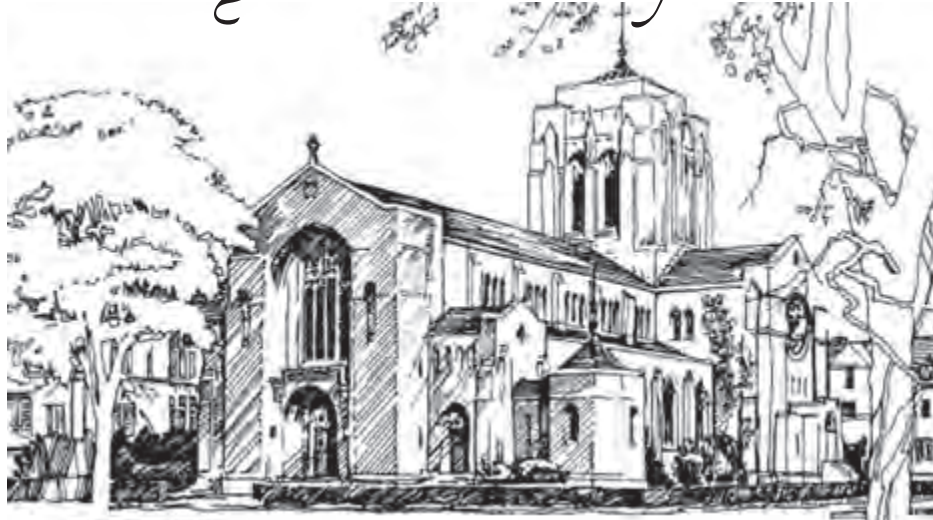

## In Memory of Msgr. Dempsey

Msgr. Michael Joseph Dempsey died on March 9. Msgr. Dempsey was ordained May 31, 1958. His first assignment in our Diocese was at St. Finbar (Brooklyn) until 1960. From 1960 to 1971 he was assistant superintendent of the Diocesan Schools Office; from 1971 to 1978 he was secretary of the Diocesan Department of Education; and from 1978 to his retirement in 2007 he was director of the Diocesan Pastoral Communications Office. From 1961 to 2010 he resided at OLQM. His funeral Mass was here at our church on Friday, March 17.

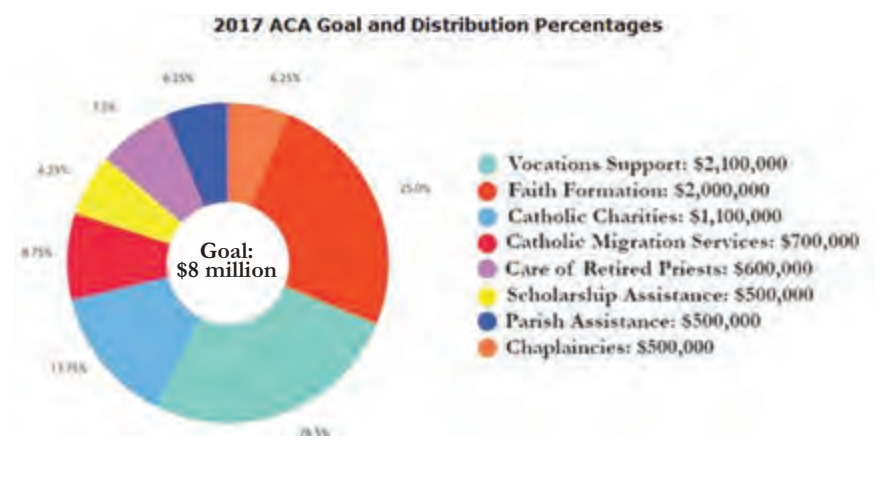

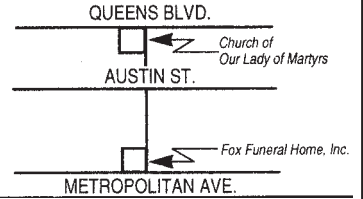

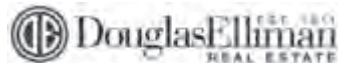
