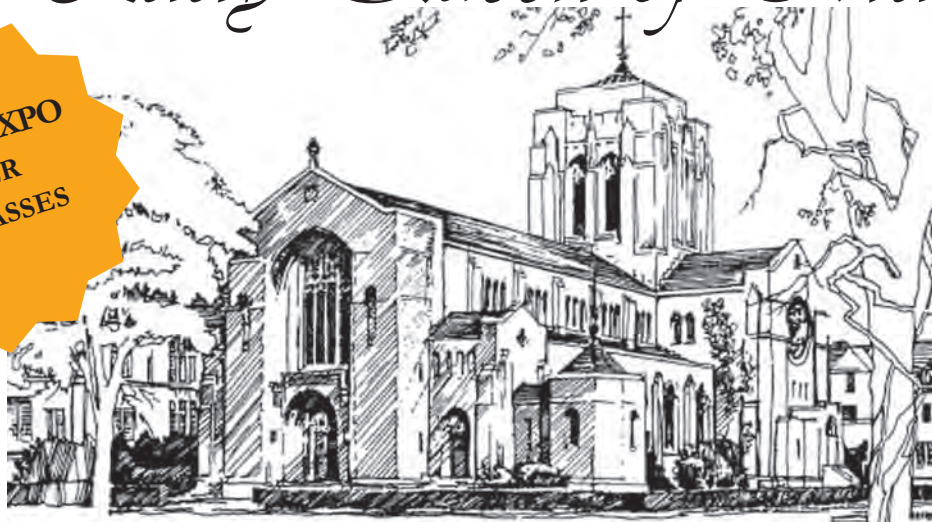

We pray together to worship God and to share our faith. Praying as a community is both powerful and comforting. Today the tables in the church vestibule are set up by representatives of our parish ministries that provide a prayerful and spiritual atmosphere in our church and in service of the needs of others.

Who you'll meet this weekend:

■ **Pastoral Care** includes our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHCs), men and women who commit themselves to minister the Eucharist to their sisters and brothers who are homebound or in local nursing homes or hospitals, and who give Communion at Mass. Pastoral Care has an intercessory prayer group that prays for special intentions upon request.

■ **Consolation/Bereavement** ministry attends wake prayer services and assists families in preparation for the Christian Funeral Rite of the Church. Bereavement support group meetings are held twice monthly for parishioners (as well as non-parishioners) who have recently suffered a loss.

■ **OLQM Choir** enhances the 11:30 a.m. Mass every Sunday, and all major liturgies throughout the year, through sacred song. The choir's motto comes from St. Augustine: "Those who sing pray twice."

■ **Charismatic Prayer Group** practices spontaneous prayer, scripture reading and the exercise of charismatic gifts. They meet regularly on Friday evenings and sponsor at least one bus pilgrimage a year.

■ **Single Adults Group** extends companionship to never married, separated/divorced or widowed individuals who are seeking social, spiritual and educational engagement; the group plans many activities and always welcomes newcomers.

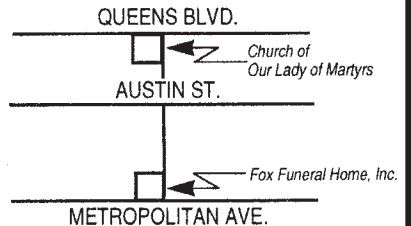
