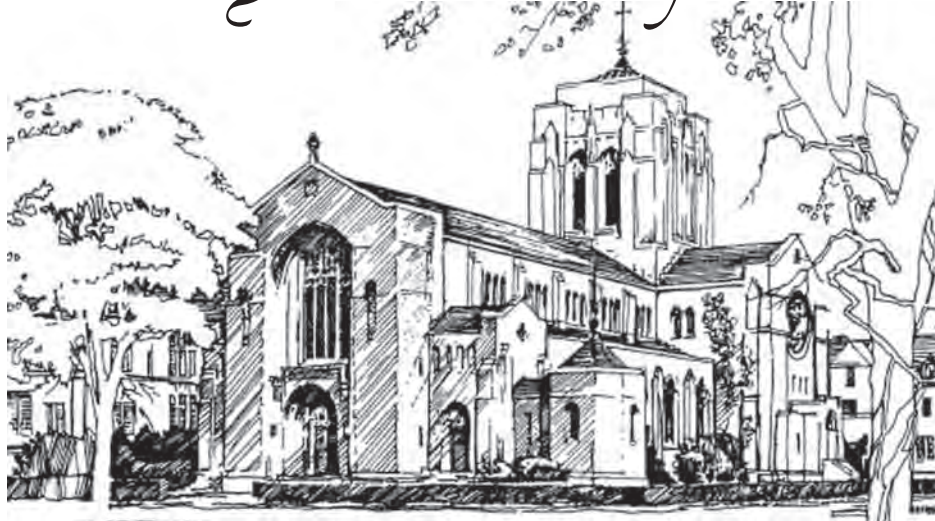

WE NEED YOUR HELP ON THE EDUCATION TAX CREDIT

We again ask that you tell your legislators in Albany to enact the Education Tax Credit before they conclude their legislative session in mid-June. Please raise your voice.

Why? Governor Cuomo's Parental Choice in Education Act will help keep Catholic schools like ours affordable by providing \$150 million in education tax credits annually. Among other things, it gives tax credits directly to low-income families who send their children to Catholic schools and scholarships to students from low- and middle-income families to attend a school of their choice.

Your gift ensures that a loved one's name will be honored. If you are interested in these new opportunities to have a door named in memory of a person or a single family, please contact Father Passenant.



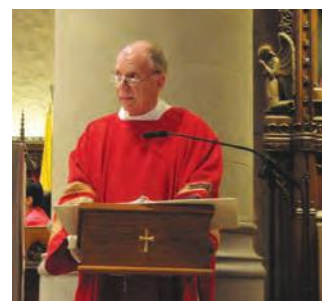
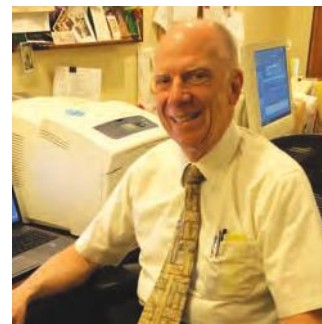

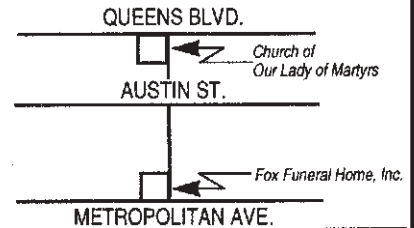
