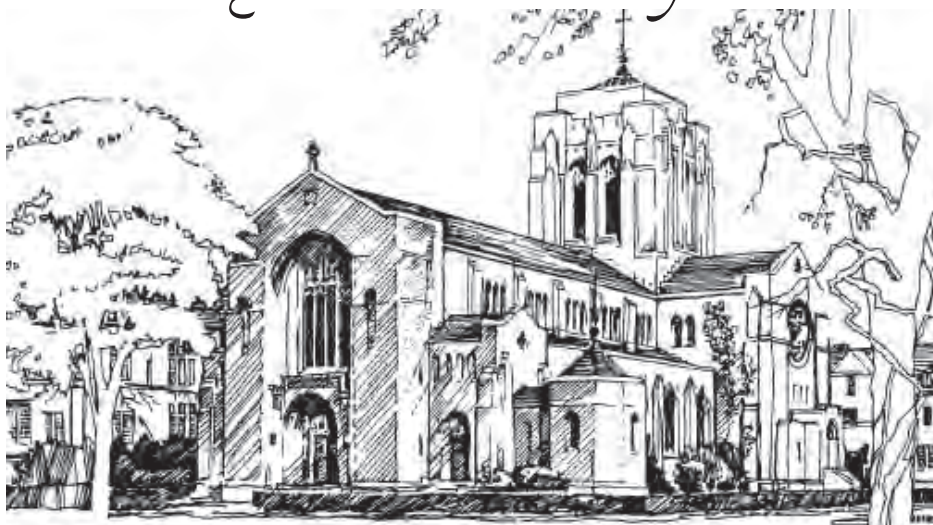

Our program is available for all children who attend public and private schools, from the first grade through high school, to supplement the religious upbringing of these children by their parents, who are the first and best teachers by their word, deed and action. Through the dedication of parents, volunteer catechists, and staff we hope to provide a loving and warm environment where our children will be able to experience the Love of God in their lives.

Wednesday, September 17.***

Children must attend a minimum of two years for preparation for reception of First Communion and a minimum of two years for preparation for Confirmation. Students are expected to continue in our program each year through grade level 8.

Wednesday evenings 7:00–8:15 p.m. Levels 3-8 and high school students
