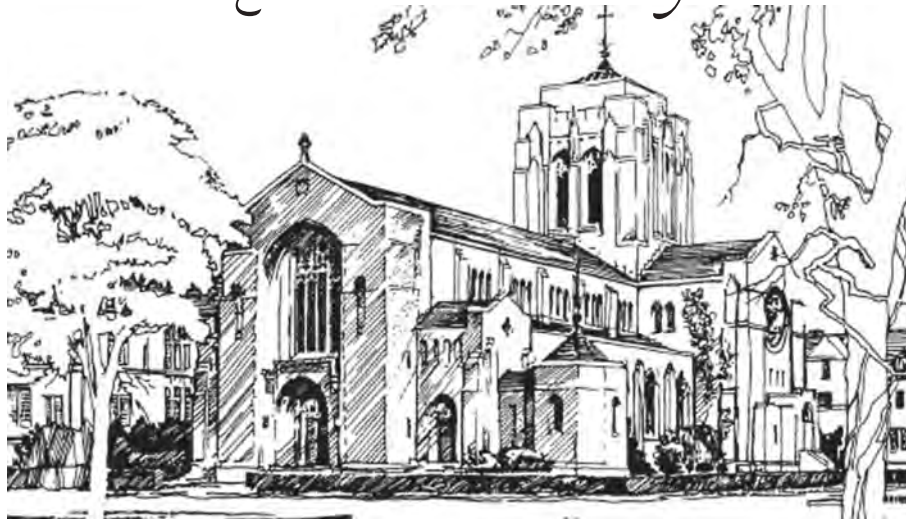

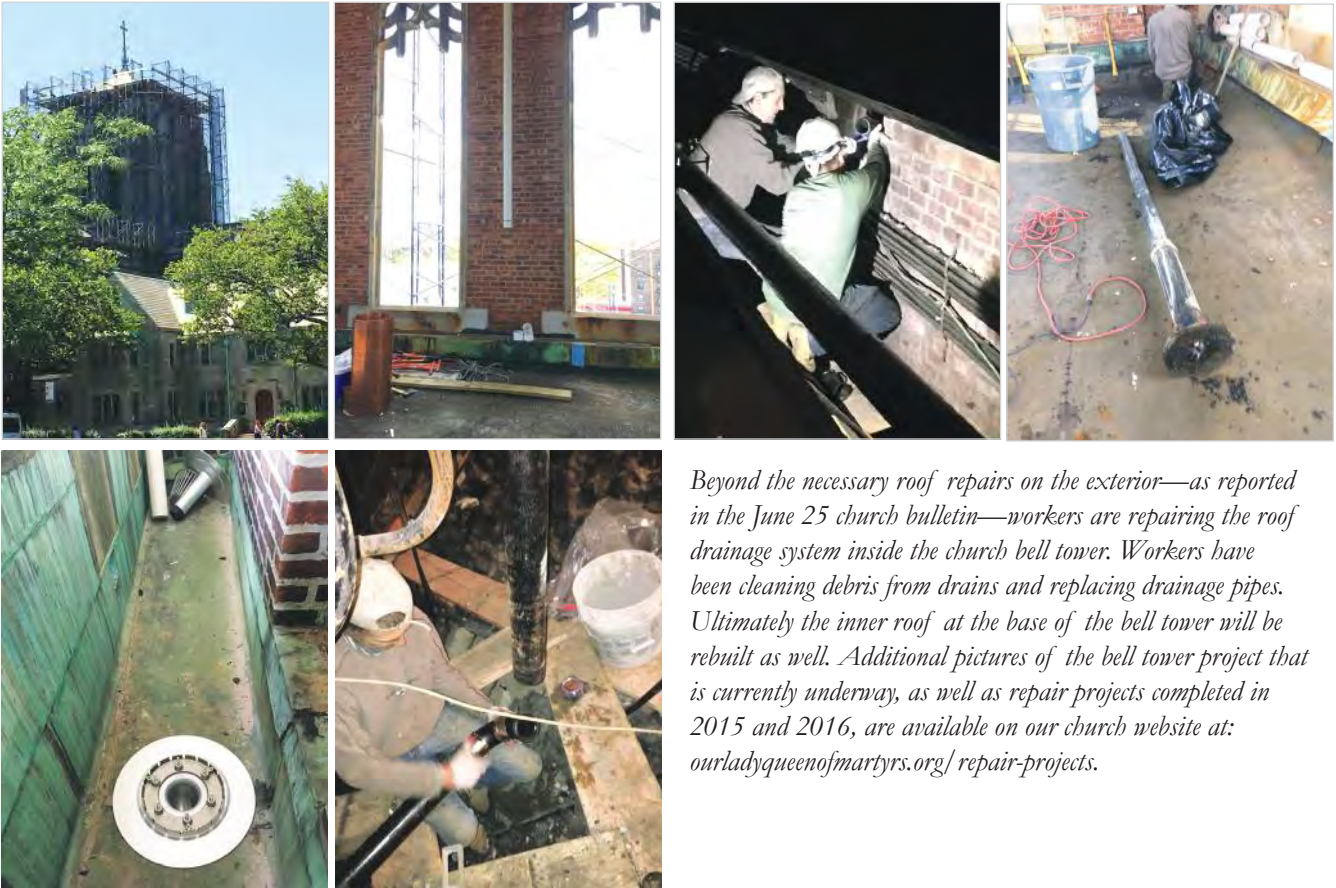

The Sound of Silence

News from the Diocese

Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program

The Diocese of Brooklyn has announced another step in its ongoing response to the sexual abuse of minors by members of the clergy. The full details of the program are explained in a letter from Bishop DiMarzio, which can be found on our parish website. The Bishop wishes to assure all of us that “not a penny of (our) contributions or bequests will go toward compensating victims of abuse. The Diocese will take out a loan to cover for the cost, and pay it back with rental income.”

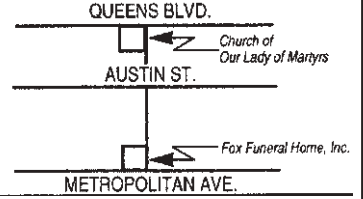
