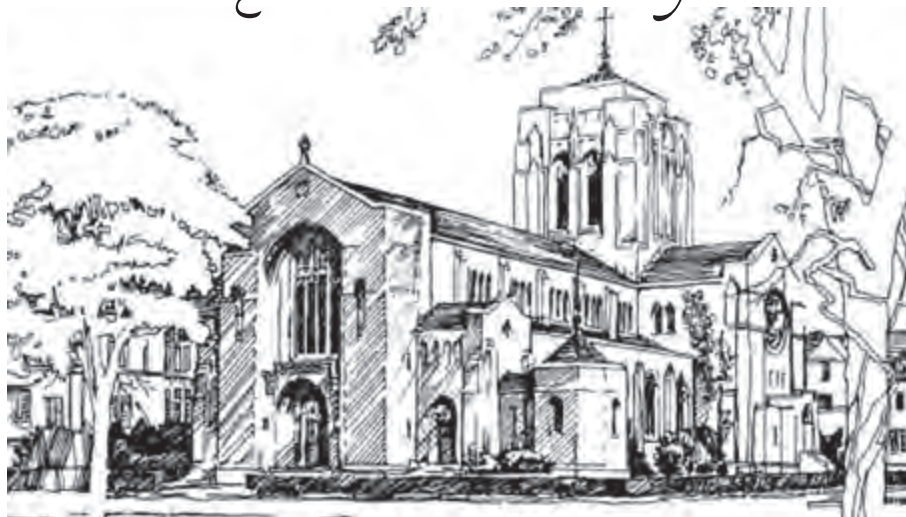

1917-2017: Centennial of Our Founding Pastor

For the 100th anniversary of the appointment of the first resident pastor of our parish, Monsignor Joseph R. McLaughlin—the man who built our Church, school, rectory and convent buildings—we are featuring some of the religious architecture at OLQM that is his legacy.

Sermons in Glass: Aisle Windows on the South Side

Father McLaughlin wrote in the *Parish Monthly* of 1941: “The use of stained glass in church decoration is not only there for the purpose of ornament, to carry out a scheme of pleasant lighting with form and color or to give religious atmosphere to the church, but also to teach spiritual lessons. The pictorial window is, in effect, a ‘Sermon in Glass,’ expressing religious ideals and preaching Catholic doctrines.”

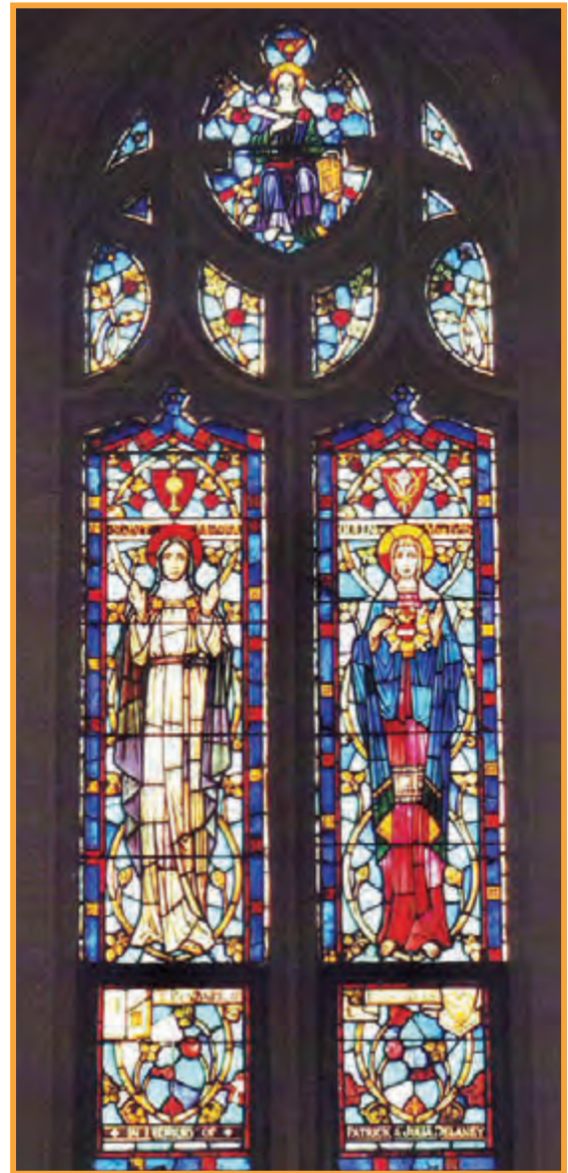
In our church, the theme of the south-facing aisle windows is Our Blessed Lady, who is depicted in her traditional aspects and alongside the figure of a saint whose chief virtue is properly associated Mary. The Sermon in Glass in the third window from the transept (pictured here) is that of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs with St. Monica. This is a fitting association of Our Sorrowful Mother, who grieved at the foot of the Cross for Her Divine Son, with St. Monica, the mother who sorrowed for her wayward son, Augustine, until, through her tears and prayers and sacrifices, he learned to love God and became a great saint too. (St. Monica’s feast day is August 27; St. Augustine’s is August 28.)

Father McLaughlin described the fifth window (not pictured) as symbolizing “the timely petition for Peace in a war-mad world.” While he wrote that in 1941, it is a theme very much alive today, as we pray that war with all its horrors may soon cease. This window, which depicts St. Therese, the Little Flower of Jesus, who was a favorite of the soldiers during World War I and had promised to spend Her Heaven doing good on earth, is fittingly inscribed with the virtue of “Charity.”

Spend some time getting acquainted with the stained glass windows in our church. Each window has its own Sermon. Each window too was given in memory of someone or as a gift of one of our church’s benefactors.

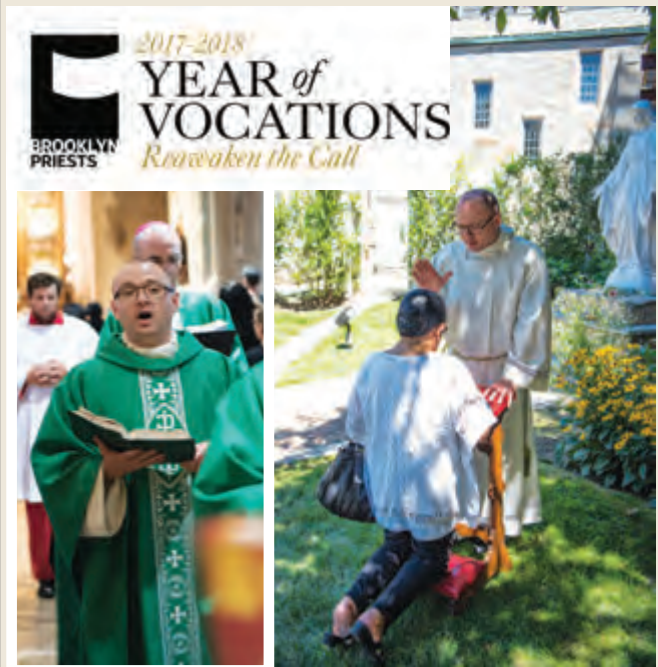

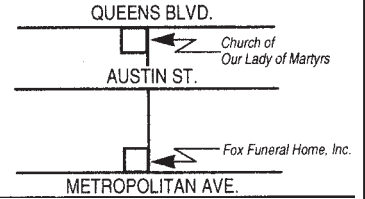

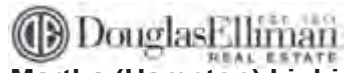
