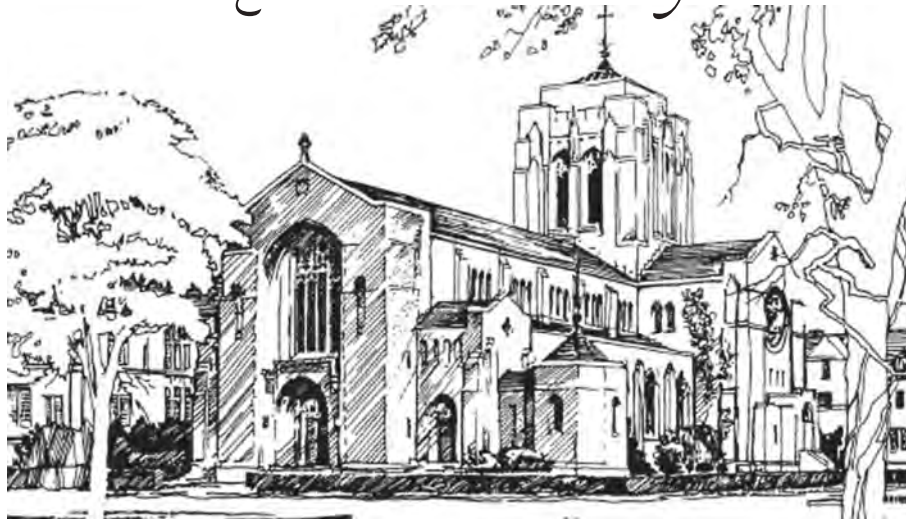

1917-2017: Centennial of Our Founding Pastor

For the 100th anniversary of the appointment of the first resident pastor of our parish, Monsignor Joseph R. McLaughlin—the man who built our Church, school, rectory and convent buildings—we are featuring some of the religious architecture at OLQM that is part of his legacy.

Sermons in Glass: Aisle Windows on the North Side

Medievalists believed that “the fire of stained glass was celestial light.” Our church, which is modeled after the English Gothic Cathedral at Durham (1093-1130), uses building techniques that let light in through enormous rose windows, a choir window, clerestory windows and the side aisle stained glass windows.

On the north side of our church the theme of the aisle windows is that of Christ, who is depicted under traditional aspects and alongside the figure of a saint whose life is properly associated with the particular aspect portrayed. In the fourth north side window (shown here), the Sermon in Glass shows Christ as The Eternal Priest, robed in priestly vestments and holding the chalice of the Holy Sacrifice. According to the *Parish Monthly* of 1941, “the motto recalls the words of Scripture: ‘Thou art a Priest forever, according to the order of Melchisidech.’ Melchisidech was the patriarchal symbol of the sacrifice of the New Testament, who [in Genesis] offered bread and wine as his priestly sacrifice to Almighty God.” With Christ is the apostle St. Jude, one of the first priests ordained by Christ at the Last Supper when He said; “Do this in memory of Me.”

The second north side window (not pictured) shows Christ as the Sacred Heart, symbolic of the infinite Love of God for all. The inscription recalls the prayer, “Sacred Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us, inflame our hearts with love for Thee!” Associated with the Sacred Heart is St. Augustine, whose feast day we celebrate on August 28 (and his mother, St. Monica, whose feast day is August 27).



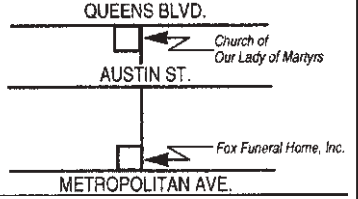
