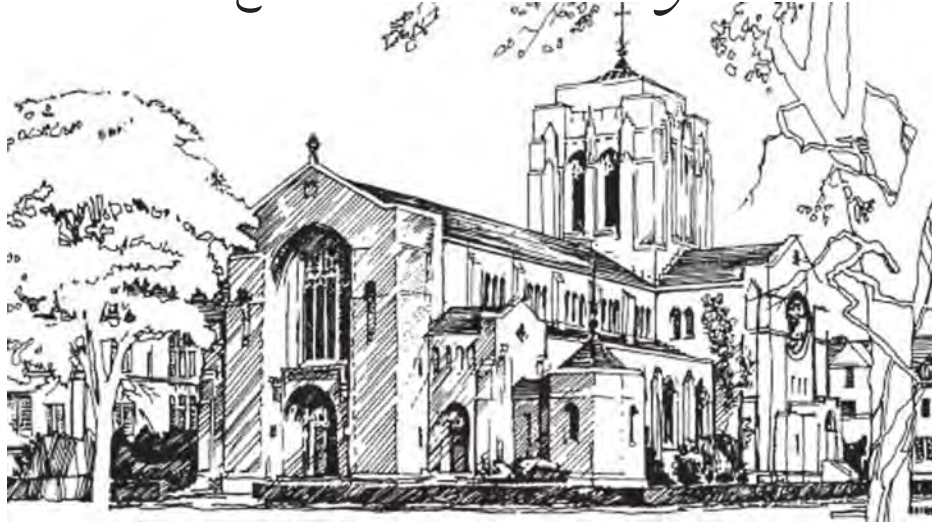

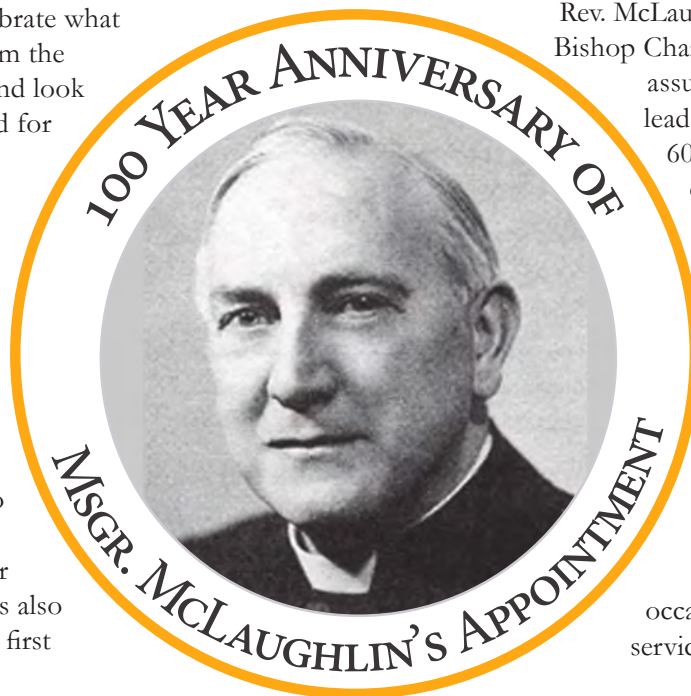

PARISH FEAST CELEBRATION Commemorating a Milestone Date for Our Parish

Today we at once celebrate what we have received from the generations of the past and look forward to all that is good for our parish future!

One hundred years ago this week Reverend (later Monsignor) Joseph R. McLaughlin was appointment pastor.

Between 1912 and 1917, the then five-year-old parish of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs had no resident priest. Then, on September 15, 1917—Our Lady of Sorrows, which is also our parish feast day—the first resident pastor arrived.



Rev. McLaughlin was appointed by Bishop Charles E. McDonnell and assumed duties as spiritual leader of the little flock of 60 Catholics and 18 children in Forest Hills. In the ensuing decades, Rev. McLaughlin oversaw an expansive building program, supervising the development of our school (1928), rectory and church structures (1938), and the convent building (1953). In 1938, on the occasion of his 20 years of service, the people of OLQM

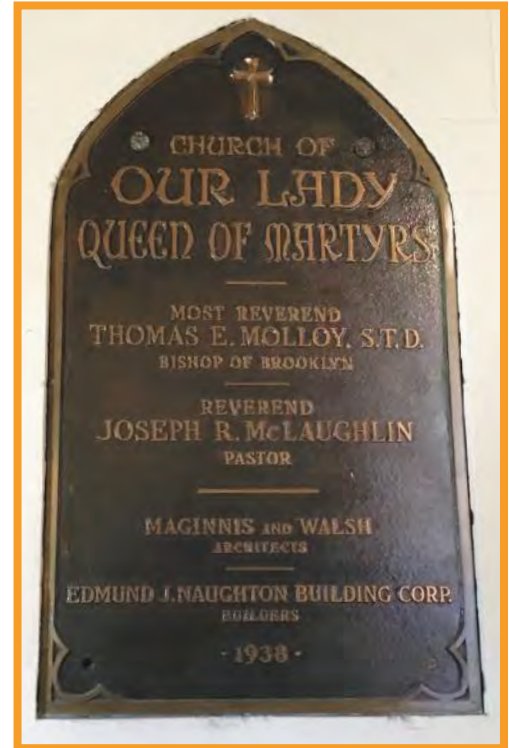
parish expressed their gratitude to their versatile pastor with a dinner honoring him at the Waldorf-Astoria. That same year, ground was broken for this church—Rev. McLaughlin’s crown achievement.

In 1944, McLaughlin was elevated by Pope Pius XII to the title of Right Reverend Monsignor.

Prosperity seemed to follow Msgr. McLaughlin during his pastorate, and his efforts and accomplishments were sustained by the unstinting support of the people of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs.

Although the times have changed from the McLaughlin years to the present, the loyalty of parishioners is still evident—through those who contribute their time, talent, and treasure to the life of this parish today; the countless Holy Communions, Baptisms, Confirmations, and Marriages at OLQM Church and graduates from the OLQM Catholic Academy; and the support we receive for programs that allow us to continue to repair, maintain, and preserve our parish buildings.

Today, we dedicate the new carillon chimes as part of our commemoration of our first pastor, Msgr. McLaughlin. So you don’t miss a moment of this great time together, our celebration of this special parish centennial will continue through the fall at our Parish Gala evening on Wednesday, November 8 at Russo’s on the Bay.

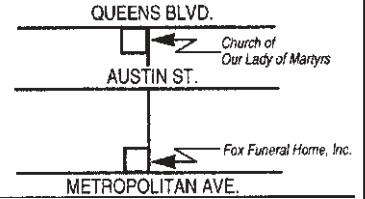
