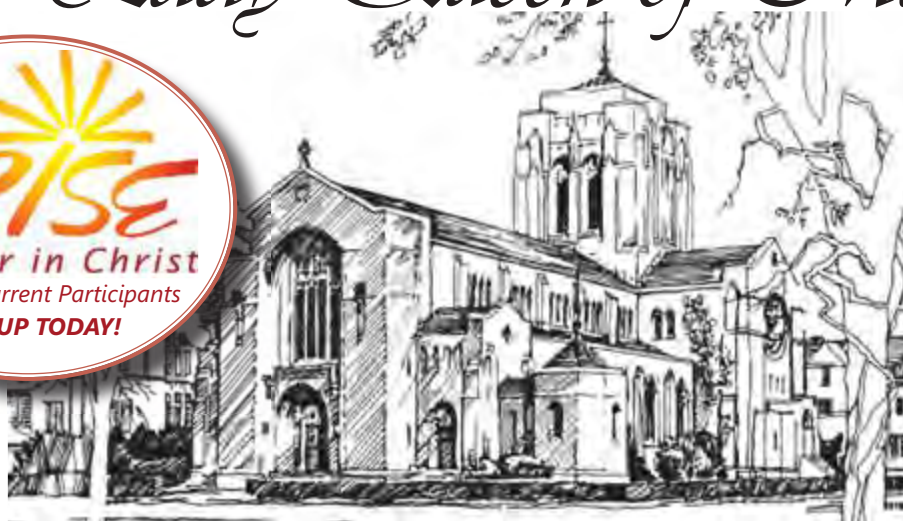

**NOVENA FOR VOCATIONS | Thursday evenings through November 9 at 7:30 p.m. in the Church**

This Thursday, Father Nicholas Spano, Order of Friars Minor Conventual (OFM Conv), Director of the San Damiano Mission in Brooklyn, will be here for our vocations prayer night. Father Spano entered the Franciscan friars' house of initial formation in Philadelphia in 2000 and professed simple vows in 2003. He has a double bachelor's in philosophy and religious studies from La Salle (2004) and a master of divinity from Washington Theological Union (2009). He did Franciscan ministry work first in Buffalo and then at Assumption Church in Syracuse (2010), working in the food pantry and soup kitchen.

In 2014 his minister provincial asked him to reopen and build up a church in Greenpoint, Brooklyn, to evangelize millennials. He was ordained a priest this past May and currently serves people in both religious and spiritual formation at San Damiano Mission.

Then and Now at OLQM

**From the church archives:** Back when Forest Hills was just farmland on which the Cord Meyer Development company and the Sage foundation were building for the future, the little white chapel that was the original OLQM church was a cathedral for Catholics in this area and a landmark for all who passed through on the Long Island railroad. Forest Hills was often identified by the gracious statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, illuminated at night, that stood on the lawn in front of the chapel. The statue was erected by Father McLaughlin shortly after his appointment to the parish to inspire virtue and goodness.



**Today:** The statue of the Blessed Mother was moved from its original site to make room for the construction of the parish school. It now stands in a landscaped garden setting, which we know as the Mary Garden, behind our current church/rectory buildings. The statue is still illuminated at night and invites peace and contemplation.

### Looking Ahead: 2018 Pilgrimage

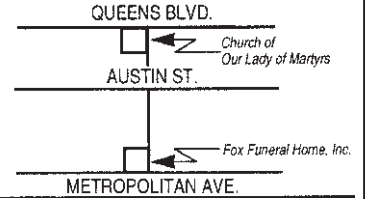
