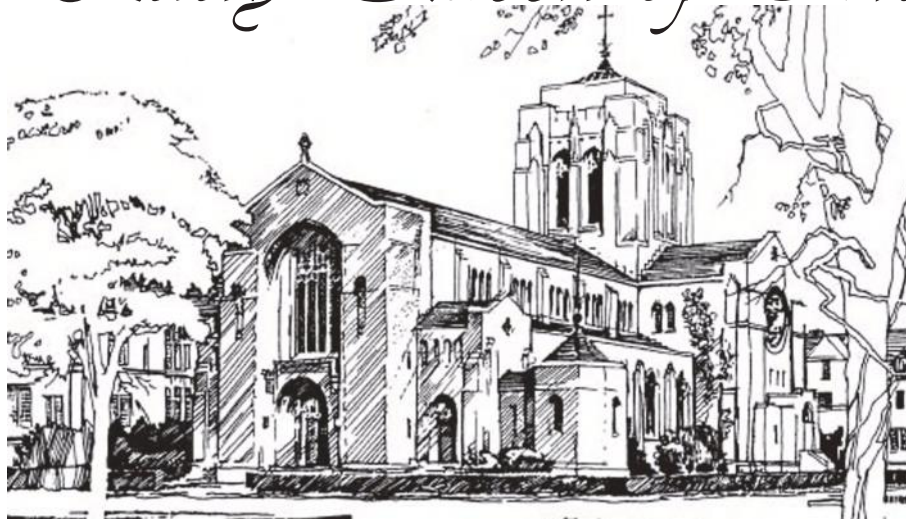

October: Month of the Rosary

October as the Month of the Rosary was established by Pope Leo XIII in 1884. The rosary is a “compendium of the entire Gospel” (Pope Pius XII). In 2002, Pope John Paul II updated the rosary by adding the Luminous mysteries on which to meditate. Pope Francis prescribes a daily rosary as spiritual medicine for heart, soul and life.

Join us to pray a public rosary—a **Living Rosary**—outside the church next **Sunday, October 8**, after 1 p.m. Mass. You can also pray the rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet in church daily with us after the 12:05 p.m. Mass, or pray a rosary privately, any day, every day!

- **Sorrowful** (Tuesdays and Fridays), to recall the Passion and death of Jesus

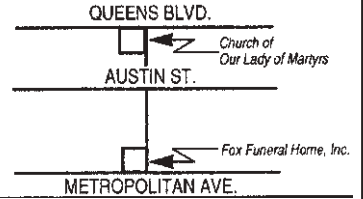
