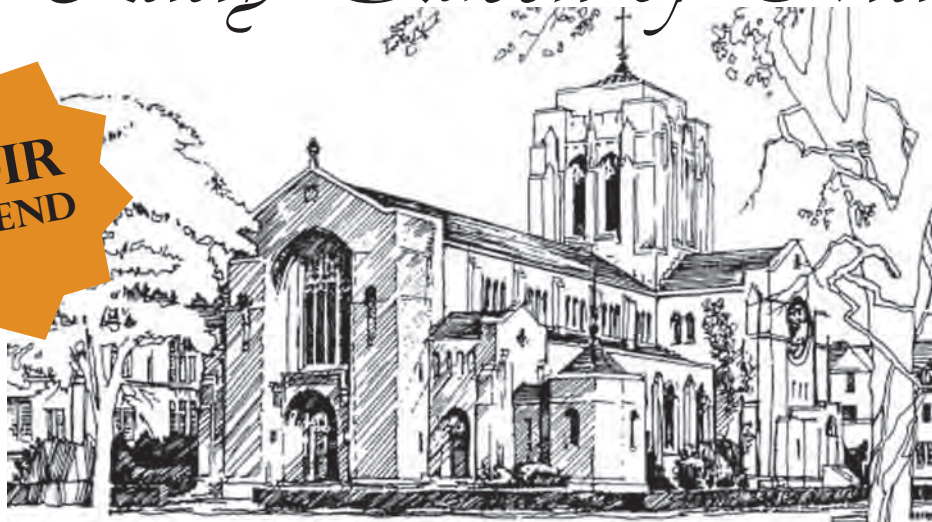

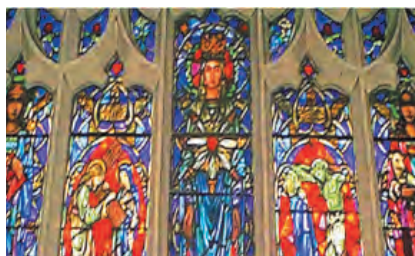
Second Collections

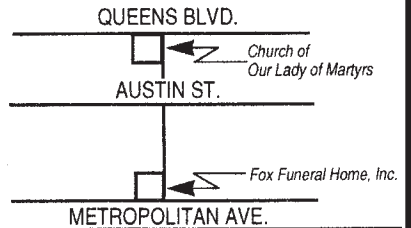
