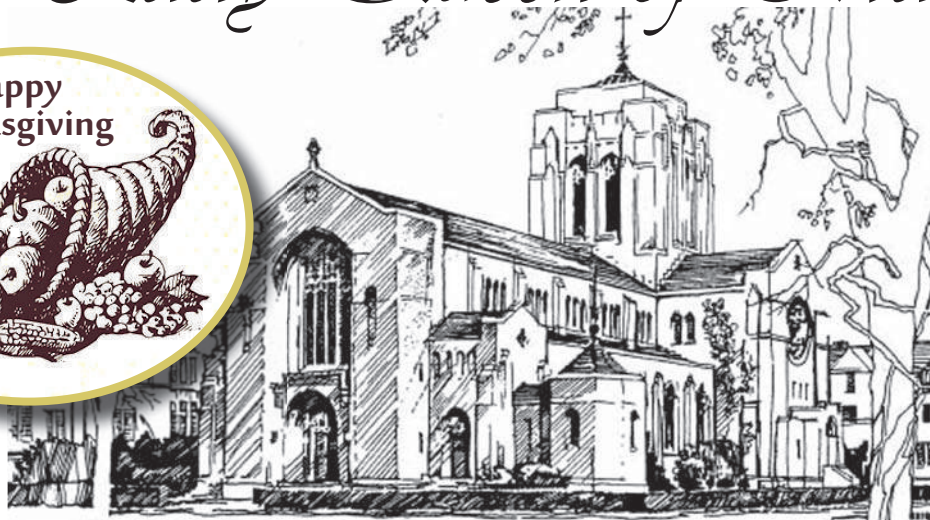

Prayers for the Faithful Departed

During November we remember those who have gone before us in faith. We pray for our own beloved family members who have died and remember those who have no one to pray for them.

November is also a time to visit the graves of our loved ones and pray for them at the site of their resting place. The office of Catholic Cemeteries encourages each of us to pre-plan our own funeral and can assist in choosing a gravesite or crypt. You can contact Catholic Cemeteries by calling **718-894-4888** or going to www.ccbklyn.org.

The remains of our loved ones deserve a final resting place as well. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB)

advises that cremated remains of a body should be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they come—from the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried, the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition.

Cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased, are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.

Let eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace; may they and all the faithful departed, rest in peace. Amen.

Remembering Father Daniel Weiscopf

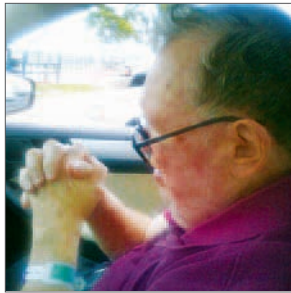
One-year Memorial Mass | 8 a.m. Friday, November 27

“Father Dan never forgot the vow he took to serve God’s people.... As one of his lifelong friends, John Fagan, put it, ‘Father Dan lives in both worlds—this one and the other one.’

“Father Dan always found time for prayer, even during his final days, and I saw Father Dan put to the test. But he could pray! And pray he did.

“As I watched him—hands clasped, head bowed—I thought he was getting better. I must have told everyone that! But little did I know he was getting better for that other world, the world that Father Dan always knew is where, someday, we truly belong.”

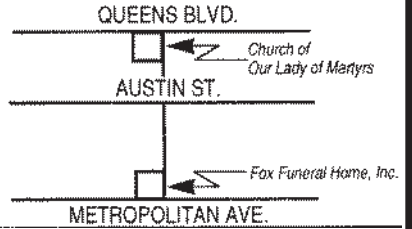
