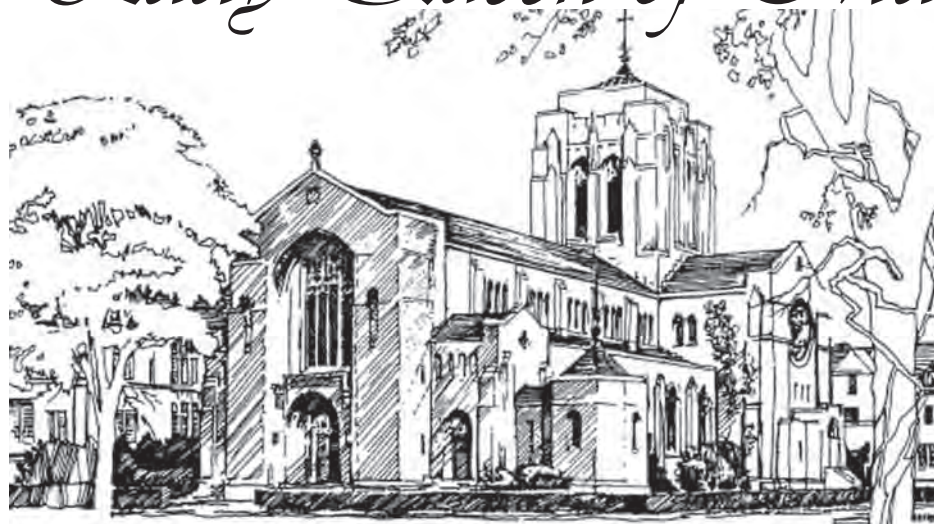

Story of the Advent Wreath

The Advent wreath is a traditional in the church as well as in the home. According to tradition, three of the candles are violet and the fourth is rose. The candles represent the four weeks of Advent. One candle is lit each week, and the rose candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent. (Some families follow a tradition of lighting a fifth candle, a white one, on Christmas Day.) The circular evergreen wreath symbolizes the world—which belongs to Christ. The ribbons knotted to the wreath remind us that we, too, belong to Christ.

When the Advent Wreath is used in the home, families will recite the opening prayer of the Sunday Mass as the candles are lit. Before or after the lighting of the candles they may share a meal, sing an Advent hymn and read from Scripture.

When the Advent Wreath is used in church, on the second and succeeding Sundays of Advent the candles are lit either before Mass begins or immediately before the opening prayer, without any additional rite or prayer.

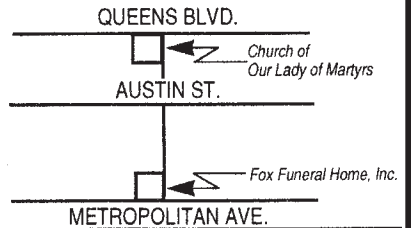
