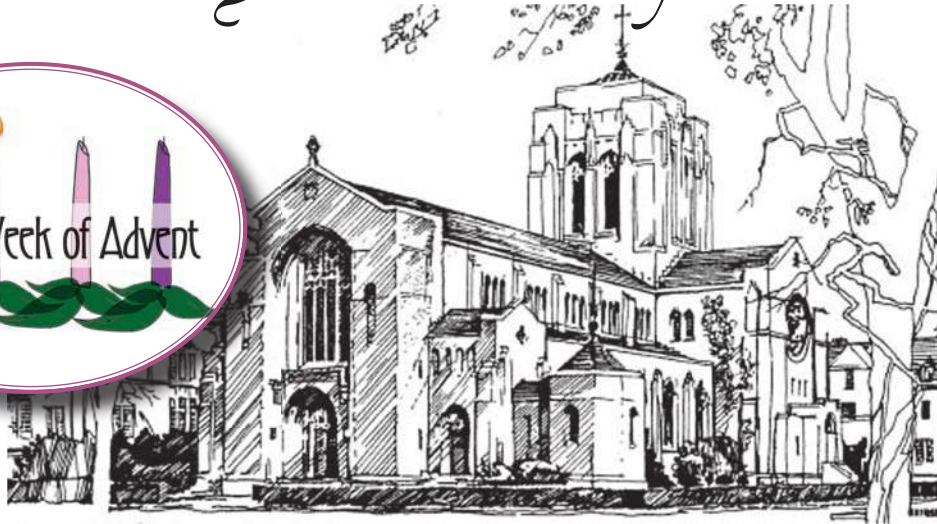

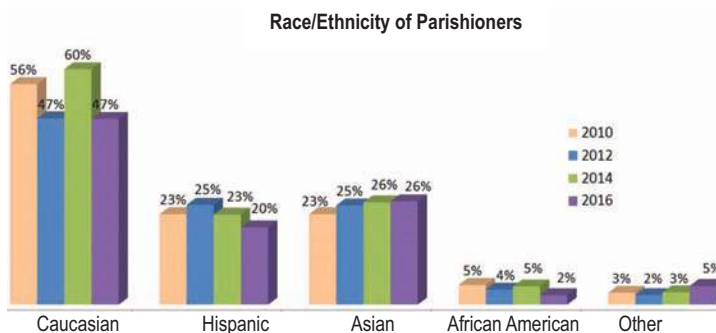
## Census Sunday 2016 Results

Parish registration is the best way to certify parish membership. Registering at OLQM is a declaration of one's desire to be a part of our Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of our parish.

In all, 590 parishioners completed a census form. Here are some of the tabulated results:

- Many of our survey participants (over 18 percent) were not officially registered with our parish.

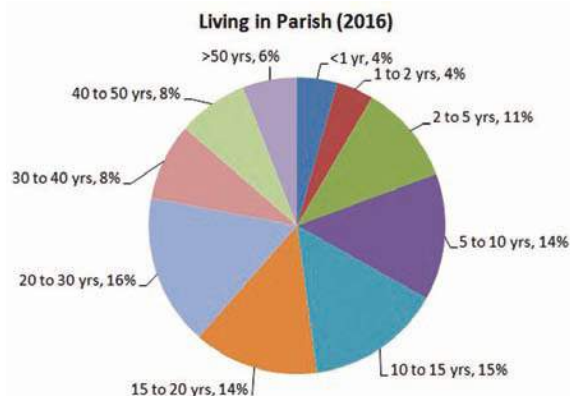

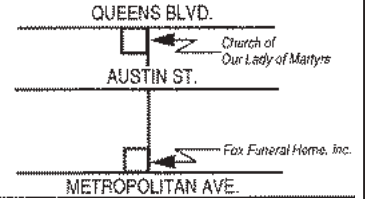
