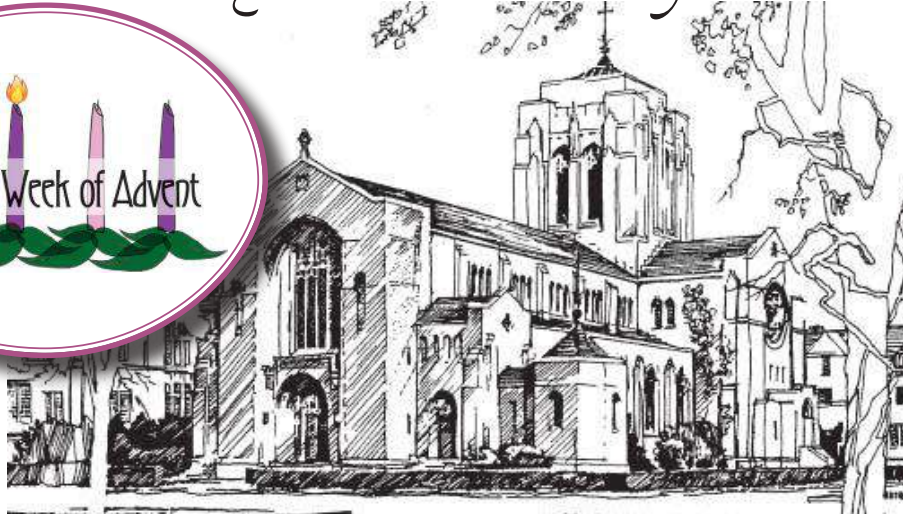

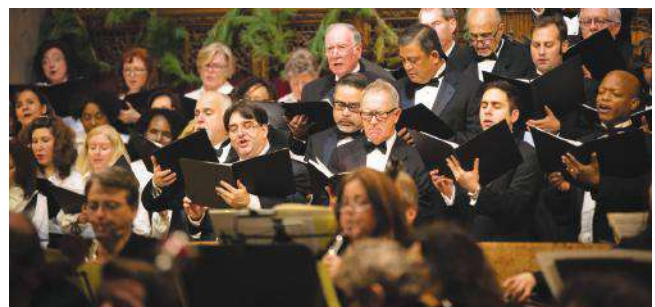

'Bambinelli' Blessings All Sunday Masses on December 16/17

In Rome, on the Third Sunday of Advent, children gather in St. Peter's Square for the noon Angelus with the Holy Father. The Pope then blesses the children and their statues of the baby Jesus (the "Bambinelli") which they bring from their Nativity sets at home. The tradition was started by Pope Paul VI in 1969 and has continued ever since.

Next weekend, which is the Third Sunday of Advent, we will observe this beautiful tradition here at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs. We ask every household, young and old, to bring a baby Jesus statue to Church and receive a blessing — a blessing that will you can bring home to refocus on the proper place Jesus has in our homes and hearts!

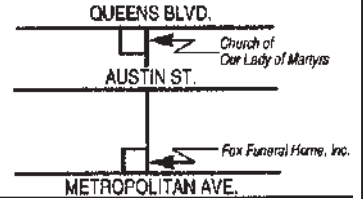
