During the special period of Advent preparation from December 17 through December 23, we are reciting (chanting)

the "O Antiphons of Advent" at the daily Masses at 8 a.m. and 12:05 p.m. Seven antiphon verses proclaim the coming of Christ as the fulfillment of our hopes. Each antiphon begins with "O" and invokes the expected Messiah according to the prophecy of Isaiah. The O Antiphons are the inspiration for the hymn "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel," which we are singing at today's Masses. Emmanuel means "God is with us."

In abbreviated form, the seven O Antiphons are printed here. For the Latin versions, we have also prepared a flier that you will find in church this week:

O Wisdom, you come forth from the mouth of the Most High. You fill the universe and hold all things together in a strong yet gentle manner. O come to teach us the way of truth.

O Lord and leader of Israel, you appeared to Moses in a burning bush and you gave him the Law on Sinai. O come and save us with your mighty power.

O Root of Jesse, you stand as a signal for the nations; kings fall silent before you whom the peoples acclaim. O come to deliver us, and do not delay.

O Key of David and scepter of Israel, what you open no one else can close again; what you close no one can open. O come to lead the captive from prison; free those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death.

O Rising Sun, you are the splendor of eternal light and the sun of justice. O come and enlighten those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death.

O King whom all the peoples desire, you are the cornerstone which makes all one. O come and save man whom you made from clay.

O Emmanuel, you are our king and judge, the One whom the peoples await and their Savior. O come and save us, Lord, our God.


