RCIA Class Welcomed on Second Sunday of Advent

The Rite of Welcome signified the official welcome from our church community to those who began their individual and collective journeys into the Catholic faith.



The candidates were joined by their sponsors during the Mass.

The sound of knocking reverberated throughout the church. Doors opened and, two at a time, the RCIA catechumens and candidates received a warm ovation from those in attendance during the 11:30 a.m. Rite of Welcome Mass on December 6. “I invite all that we have welcomed,” Bishop Sanchez said, before greeting the candidates individually on the altar and blessing them with the sign of the cross.

The sextet of **Cecelia Chang, Irene Cimato, Yolanda Custodio, Bobby Iype, Lily Pan, and Ronald Rivas** are preparing for reception of sacraments of initiation—Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist—which they will receive at the Easter Vigil.

To complete their full initiation into the church are **Michelle Carvalho, Paola Hornbuckle, Cintia Ochoa,**

Jamie Ong, Keisha Waldropt, and Katherine Woo. They will receive sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

Three additional candidates—**Peter Buenger, Catherine Chua, and Justin Moore**—were baptized in a Christian faith tradition and will be making a profession of faith.

“You have been marked by the sign of Love,” said Bishop Sanchez, invoking God’s love to assist the class to “persevere.” This class of 15 will attend Masses over the next 15 weeks to hear the Word of God, then be dismissed to discuss and study it.

“I see hope,” Deacon Greg Kandra said during the homily. “You are declaring belief. You want to bring light.”

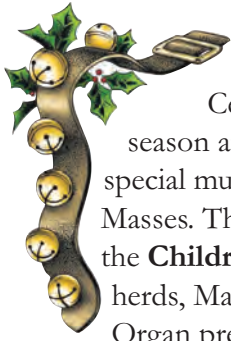

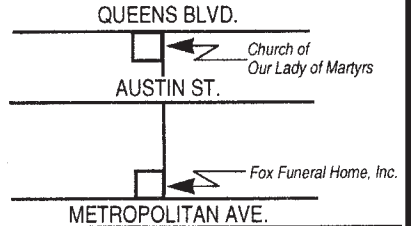
