



The Twelve Days of Christmas

Most of us know the music and lyrics of "The Twelve Days of Christmas," which are the days from Christ's birth to the visit of the Magi. The song's origin is complicated, but by one interpretation there is religious symbolism in this popular Christmas song:

"My true love" refers to God.

"A partridge in a pear tree" refers to the gift of Jesus, the Son of God.

"Two turtle doves" refers to Old and New Testaments.

"Three French hens" refers to Faith, Hope and Charity.

"Four Calling Birds" refers to the four Gospels.

"Five Golden Rings" refers to the first five Books of the Old Testament, or the "Pentateuch," with the account of man's fall from grace.

"Six Geese A-laying" refers to the six days of creation.

"Seven Swans A-swimming" refers to the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, the Seven Sacraments.

"Eight Maids A-milking" refers to the eight Beatitudes.

"Nine Ladies Dancing" refers to the nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit.

"Ten Lords A-leaping" refers to the Ten Commandments.

"Eleven Pipers Piping" refers to the eleven faithful apostles.

"Twelve Drummers Drumming" refers to the twelve points of doctrine in the Apostles' Creed.


