Novena in Honor of St. John Vianney

St. John Vianney was a 19th century French priest who so thoroughly transformed his small country parish from one of the worst in France to a veritable heaven on earth that he is revered today as the patron saint of priests. Thousands throughout France and beyond traveled to his parish so that he could hear their confessions, and so he is also recognized as a great source of help for those seeking forgiveness or a fresh start in life. There are hundreds of parishes dedicated to him throughout the world. A statuette of St. John Vianney resides on our main altar reredos.

Every year, our parish prays the novena for priests in the days leading to St. John Vianney's Feast Day of August 4. The novena carries special importance this year when our diocese is focusing on vocations. It begins Friday, July 27, at the 12:05 p.m. Mass. On Sunday, July 29, we will welcome **newly ordained Fr. Jose Diaz**, who will celebrate the 11:30 a.m. Choir Mass and lead us in the third day of the novena. Those attending this Mass will have an opportunity to receive a first blessing from Fr. Diaz.

As part of our novena we will ask everyone to lend spiritual support to the 42 seminarians in our diocese and to select one of them from our prayer sign-up sheet and make him your prayer intention for this period. Then, on August 4, **Fr. Joseph Cunningham, senior priest in residence at OLQM** who has dedicated himself to unending service to the Church, will celebrate the 5 p.m. Vigil Mass and conclude the novena.

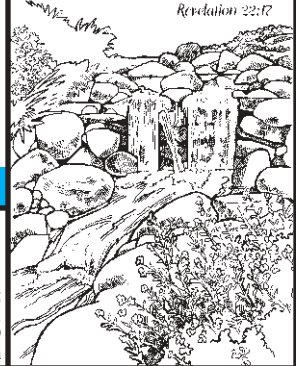

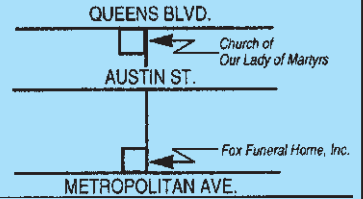
