ACADEMY BUILDING REPAIRS UNDERWAY

Our fall fundraising raffle, which in the past ran in conjunction with the “Golf and Tennis Classic” and later the “Annual Parish Gala,” is a standalone activity this year. The proceeds from this endeavor will help us to continue to maintain the account that will be used to repair the school building that houses our Catholic academy.

The pictures below show the work being done on the area near the building’s chimney above the boiler room. It includes pointing work on the chimney as well as the installation of a new outdoor waterproof membrane on the ground surface.

This job is part of a needed repair to alleviate the water penetration into the building. We were counseled that waiting on this project would only incur further erosion and become a bigger expense. The cost of this project is \$47,500. Please support our “Fall Fling” raffle to help recoup some of this expense.

St. John Vianney Novena At Today’s 11:30 a.m. Mass Celebrant: Father Jose Diaz



Fr. Diaz will share his discernment story and offer a first blessing.

We are pleased to have Fr. Jose Diaz join us today to celebrate one of his first Masses following his ordination to priesthood. Fr. Diaz, who as a seminarian spent time at OLQM in 2017, was ordained a priest on June 30 by Bishop DiMarzio. He will lead us in day three of our novena to the patron saint of priests and,

after Mass, parishioners will have an opportunity to receive a first blessing from him.

Fr. Diaz is the son of immigrants from the Dominican Republic, Jose and Raisa, here in Queens. He attended their parish school, Blessed Sacrament, Jackson Heights, and later, St. John’s Prep, Astoria. It was during his senior year that a friend offered him advice to attend a retreat at the Hispanic Charismatic Center in the Bronx. That retreat, Fr. Diaz said, “changed my life. I came to a deep and personal encounter with Jesus.” After high school, he attended Nassau Community College and Queensborough College then transferred to the Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio, to study theology and philosophy. Opening his heart to the possibility of his vocation, he lived in a discernment house for the Third Order Regular of St. Francis. That experience brought him back to New York, where he applied to be a seminarian for the Diocese of Brooklyn. He finished his studies in Douglaston and St. Joseph’s Seminary, Yonkers. As a transitional deacon, he served in St. Leo’s parish, Corona.

Let’s warmly welcome Fr. Diaz and also lend spiritual support to the 42 seminarians now studying in our diocese. You can select one of them from our prayer sign-up sheet and make him your special prayer intention. All this week we’ll pray the St. John Vianney novena at the 12:05 p.m. daily Mass. Joseph Cunningham**, senior priest in residence at OLQM who dedicates himself to unending service to the Church, even in retirement, will celebrate the 5 p.m. Vigil Mass and lead the prayer to conclude the novena.

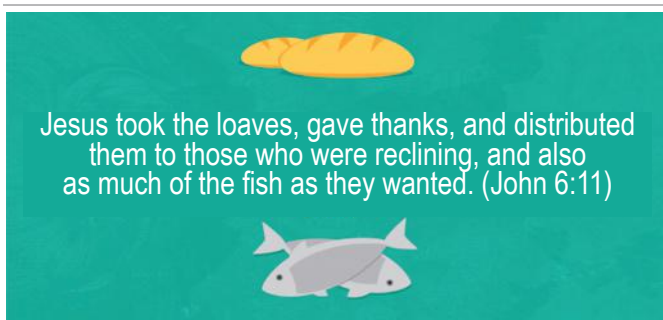

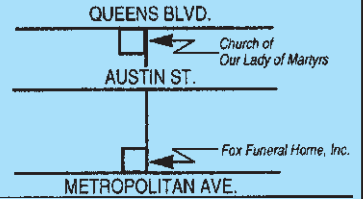
