NOVENA IN HONOR OF ST. ANTHONY

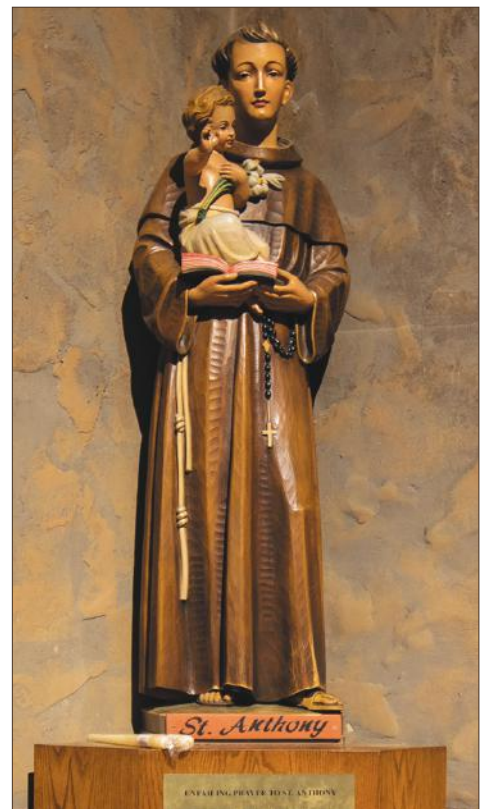

Since the tragic and horrific events of Charlottesville, Virginia, just one year ago, we have seen the effect racism has had on our society. The Bishops of the United States want to address the sin of racism. Here in the Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens, Bishop DiMarzio has formed a commission on Racism and Social Justice to deal with the social and religious problems that racism in all of its forms presents to us. 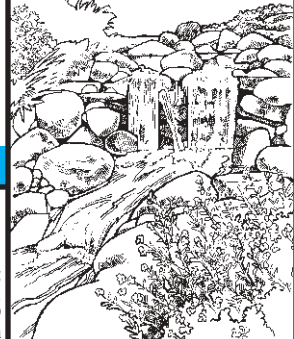

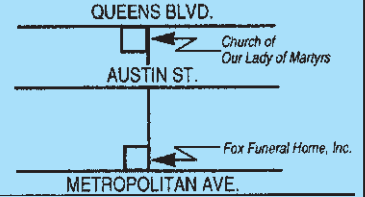
