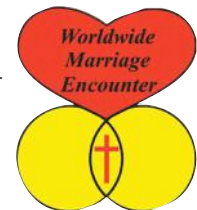
Religious Freedom Week: June 22-29

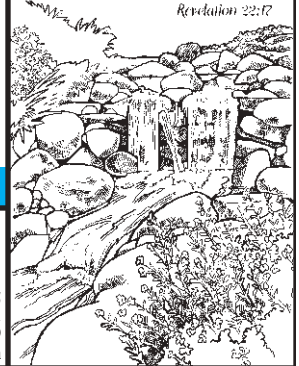

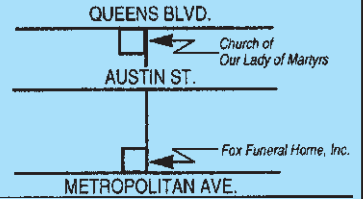
