St. Anthony Novena: June 5–13

St. Anthony is invoked for helping to recover lost items, among other intentions. We'll pray the novena at the 12:05 p.m. daily Mass, Monday through Saturday, starting on June 5, and after the 11:30 a.m. Sunday Mass on June 10. At the conclusion of the novena on the Feast Day of St. Anthony—June 13—we'll distribute St. Anthony Bread. The blessed bread is a traditional offering made to those in need, in thanksgiving to God for blessings received through the prayers of St. Anthony.

OLQMCA 6th Grade Team Wins Resurrection Ascension/St. Stan's Basketball Tournament

The season began with more players than anticipated interested in joining the sixth-grade OLQMCA basketball team, so we ended up forming two teams. The second team of players had never played together, and most did not know one another. But basketball is a sport where friendships are readily formed, and after several games and practices, the team was having a great time winning game after game during the season. As the season ended, the team had a record of 10 wins and 2 losses.

Entering the CYO Playoffs, there was confidence the team would go into several rounds, but unfortunately, the first game was against an extremely well-coached and talented team from St. Sebastian. St. Sebastian won. The playoffs are a single-game elimination.

However, OLQM had generously registered the team in the Resurrection Ascension – St. Stan's Tournament, which the two schools have coordinated for a number of years. Our team won the first three games of this tournament, but in the fourth game, we faced the same team that had eliminated us in the CYO Playoffs. Once again, St. Sebastian won with great defense, outrebounding OLQM, giving them more opportunities to score. The Tournament is a two-game elimination, so teams that lose enter a "bottom bracket" and have a chance to ultimately make their way back to the Championship game.

In this bracket, OLQM was up against another talented team in St. Margaret's Queen of Peace. With great teamwork we prevailed, which sent OLQM to the Championship game against undefeated St. Sebastian. Prior to that game, our team held a two-hour practice focused on each of St Sebastian's star players and boxing out their

top rebounder, making it difficult for their center to catch the ball in the paint, and staying close to their three-point shooter. During the Championship game, our game plan showed results early on as our defense—led by Rocco, Alvi, Aarav, Matthieu, Andrew, James, Hamlet, Adam and Tres—contained their scoring and our star player Eric continued to run the fast break, outscoring their team and amassing a lead that extended over 10 points by halftime.

It's not easy to keep a good team down, though, and St. Sebastian started chipping away at that lead during the third and fourth quarters, showing why they had beat us in the previous two games. In the final minutes we huddled and I asked each player to "do their jobs," outwork St. Sebastian's players, and stick to our game plan. The team rose to the challenge, but still St. Sebastian brought the game to within two points. Our collective defense prevailed and OLQM became Tournament Champions.

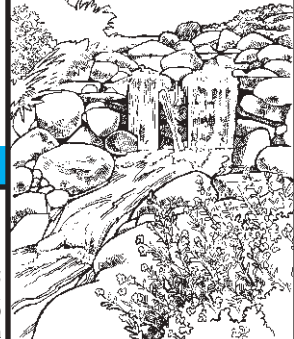

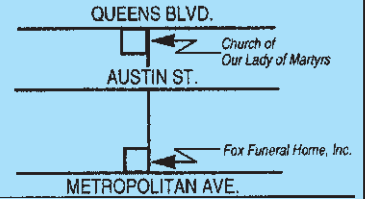
