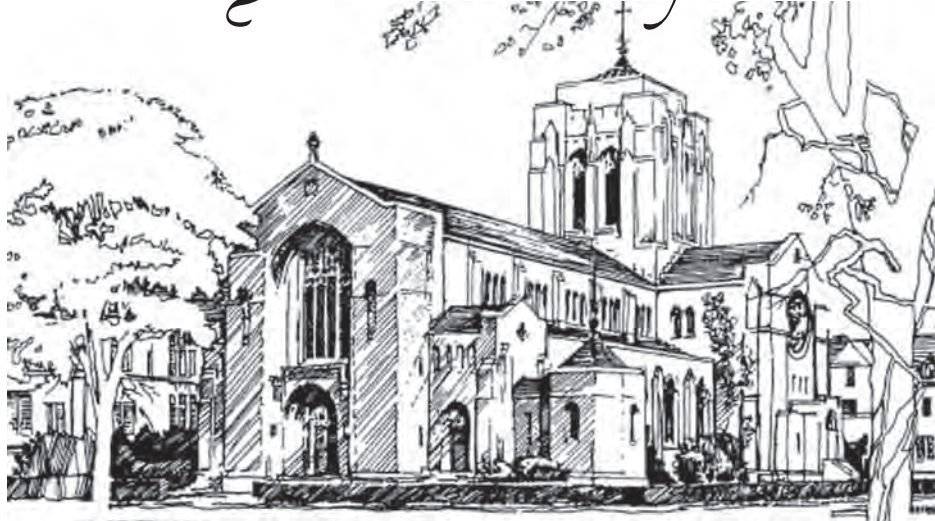

**MARTYRS SWEEP in BROOKLYN**  
*Winning Streak at 4 Games*

After defeating the defending CYO champions of McLaughlin Hall, the 8th Grade girls went on the road and earned three hard-fought victories against division rivals. Martyrs girls defeated St. Mary Winfield at Woodside 33–21, St. Patrick’s in Bay Ridge 31–23, and St. Vincent Ferrer in Brooklyn 40–36.

**Olivia Sackity** dominated the backboards on both ends of the court and contributed 8 points against St. Mary Winfield. **Grace Collins** continued her hot shooting, pouring in 11 second-half points and 17 for the game. **Christina Fitzgerald** and **Veronica McCarthy** rounded out the scoring with four points each.

Led by Fitzgerald with 8 points, Martyrs defeated a well-coached and highly motivated St. Patrick’s squad on their home court in Brooklyn. Tied at the half, second-half baskets by **Yasmin Worrel**, Fitzgerald, Collins and McCarthy made the difference in the Saturday afternoon game in Brooklyn.

The girls found another tough and highly motivated opponent waiting for them. Down by two points at the half but led by newcomer **Karina Mogha**, Martyrs rallied with 24 second-half points against St. Vincent Ferrer. Sharp shooter Collins led the second -half explosion with 10 points, with Sackity and McCarthy contributing four points each. **Gabriella Segovia** continued to contribute strong defense and rebounding to help get the victory.

**St. Pio of Pietrelcina, Pray for Us**

This month we pray a Novena to St. Pio. Born in Italy in 1887, he was ordained at age 16 and became known as “Padre Pio” to his parishioners. Padre Pio loved to pray the Rosary and prayed the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus daily. He had the gift of healing, prophecy, miracles, discernment of spirits, and the gift of tongues (to speak and understand languages he never studied) and of conversions. He lived the Franciscan life of poverty with detachment from self, possessions and comforts. He saw the image of Christ in the poor, the suffering and the sick, and gave himself to them. He died in 1968, at age 81, with his Rosary in his hands. His last words were *Gesú, Maria—Jesus, Mary.*

Pope John Paul II canonized him on June 16, 2002. St. Pio prayer groups are now spread throughout the world.

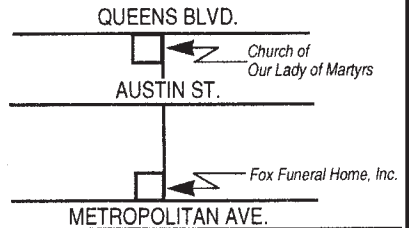
