

Bell Tower Roof Repairs Completed

In summer 2017, we embarked on a project to repair the bell tower's roof and interior. The size and scale of the job took the better part of the year to complete. The full set of pictures documenting the work and the conditions before, during and after the repairs are posted on our website at ourladyqueenofmartyrs.org/repair-projects.









Photos—With the scaffolding removed, (1) the restored ornamental cross atop the bell tower was revealed. Other repair/restoration work that is now completed: (2) installation of copper flashings at joints to eliminate roof leaks; (3) removal of old slate shingles and re-slating; (4) restoration of the decorative copper gutter hangers and downspouts. (5) The inner roof and floor inside the bell tower were also repaired to accommodate the digital church bells/chimes and speaker system, which was installed and dedicated in September 2017, in advance of our parish feast day.




