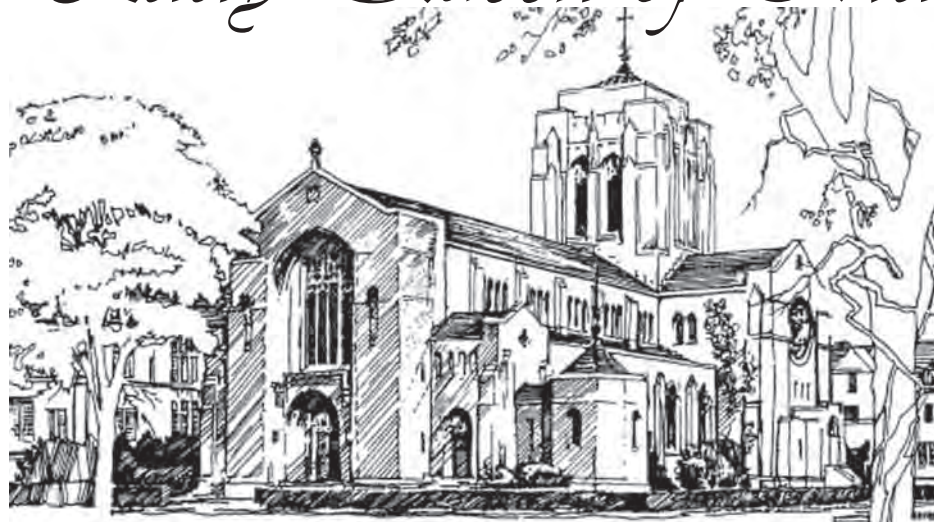

Education Tax Credit Bill

Within this month and next, we expect to hear more about the Education Tax Credit (ETC) bill in New York State. The governor and a variety of legislators support the ETC. Nineteen states offer ETC assistance to tuition-paying families and public schools.

New York's families have been waiting too long. Tuition-paying families pay taxes to support children in public schools as well as nearly \$4 billion each year in

tuition to a religious or independent school. Without access to Catholic, Jewish and independent schools, more parents will be forced to enroll their children in overburdened public schools at a significantly higher cost to taxpayers. Please watch for further information on this bill, at which time we will encourage you to contact your legislators in order to urge their support of the bill. Thank you.

A materials fee of \$40 is due at the first class. Your Baptismal Certificate and First Communion information are also required by that date. 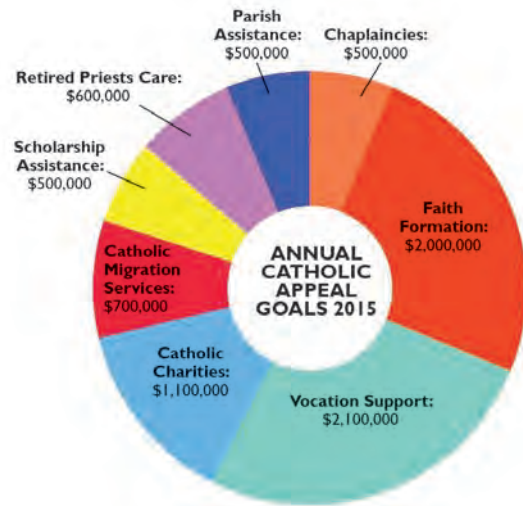

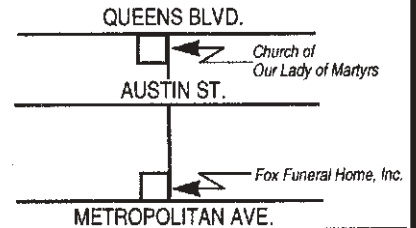
