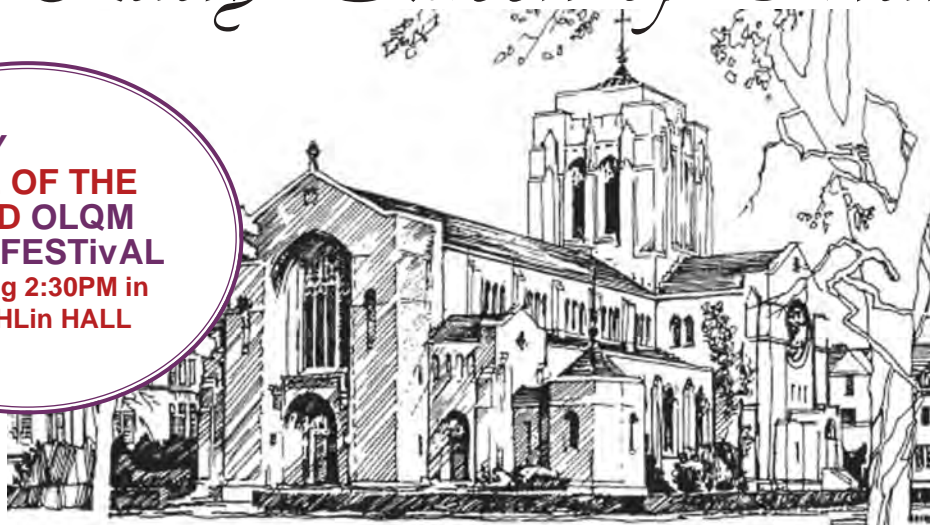

### From Bishop DiMarzio

### Decree for Dispensation for Abstinence of Meat for St. Patrick’s Day

Abstaining from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent is a penitential practices required of all the faithful who have attained the age of 14. This year the Feast of St. Patrick, March 17, falls on a Friday in Lent. Given the parades and many celebrations that occur on this day, and in view of the fact that it is the patronal feast of our neighbors in the Archdiocese of New York, in accord with the normal law, I hereby grant to all Catholics of the Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens, as well as all present here that day, a dispensation from abstinence from meat and meat products.

I strongly encourage all who make use of this dispensation to engage in another sacrificial or charitable act that day.

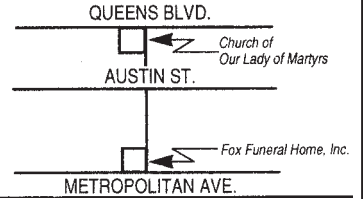
