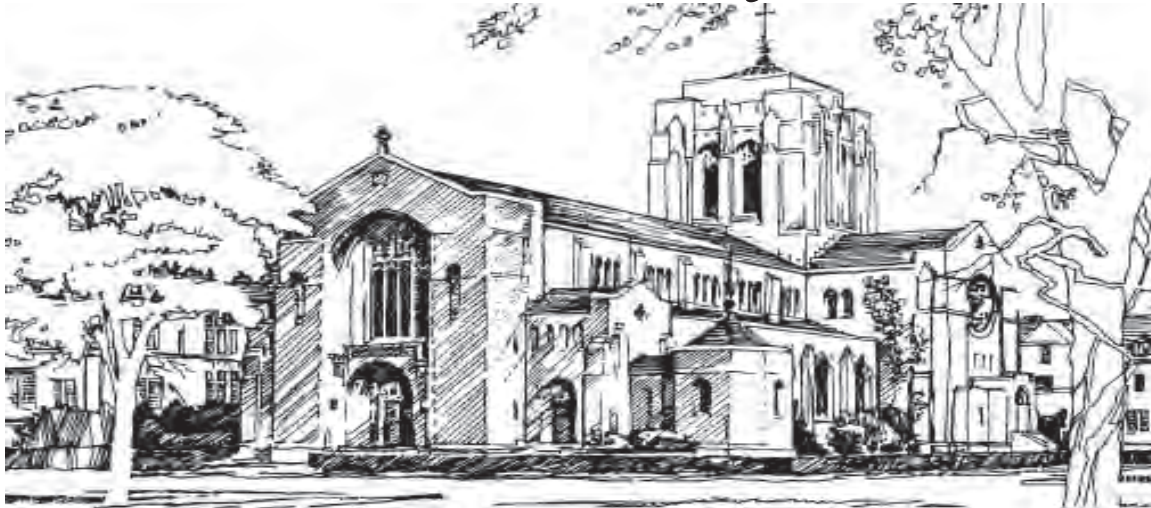

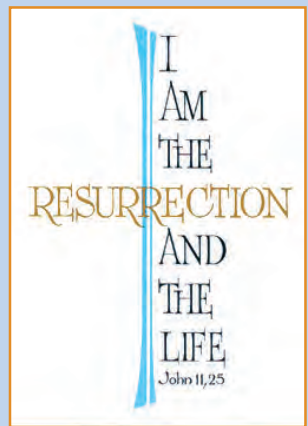

FROM THE PASTOR

Next Sunday, we celebrate Palm Sunday. Easter is fast approaching. Lent is almost done. But this week, before we turn a critical corner and prepare to relive Christ's passion and death, we find ourselves once again standing with Jesus outside the tomb of Lazarus, as He prepares to call him forth from death. It's one of the most dramatic and riveting passages in all of Scripture. And it is a fitting climax to our Lenten observance.

In this Gospel reading, Christ's own resurrection two weeks from now is foreshadowed. And so is our own return to life from the tomb of sin. This could be a good time for each of us to assess what we have discovered during our Lenten journey. Christ is calling to us, as he called to Lazarus, to come out. To leave behind sin. Do we hear Him? Our Lenten journey is nearing an end. But the great work of living as faithful Christians goes on. And, like Lazarus, we can also be given a new lease on life.

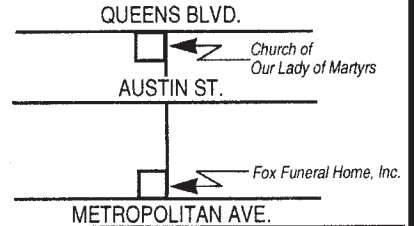
