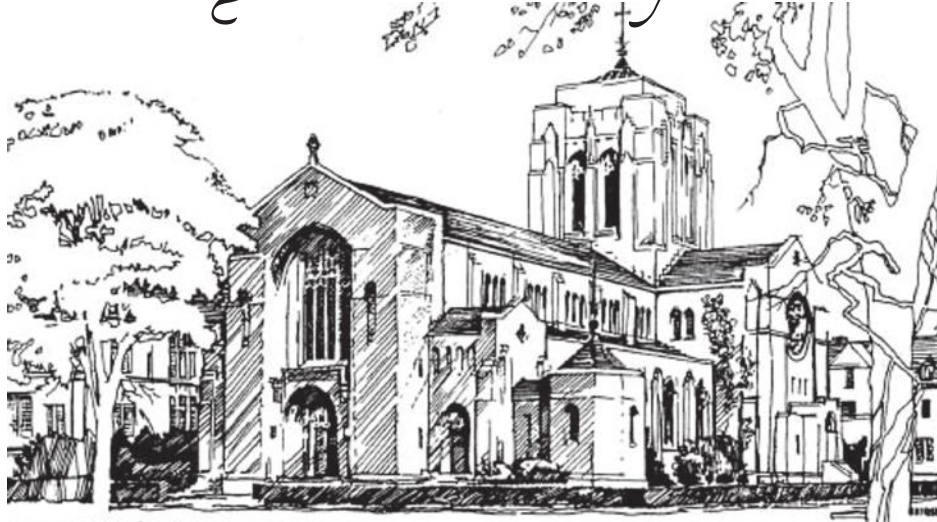

### Clarification on School Support Second Collection Envelopes

The Parish Finance Committee met on Tuesday, April 19 and recommended that we clarify the purpose of the periodic second collection envelope marked “School Support.” Bishop DiMarzio has mandated that all parish Catholic elementary schools become academies. Our Lady Queen of Martyrs School officially became an academy in September 2015. With that change, a Board of Members was seated composed of Bishops Massa and Sanchez, Father Passenant, Superintendent Thomas Chadzutko, and Deputy Superintendents Anthony Biscione and Brother Ralph Darmento, FSC. A Board of Directors was also seated composed of generous and dedicated volunteers who meet monthly to assist Principal Anne Zuschlag with the running of the school.

Our Lady Queen of Martyrs parish remains responsible for the maintenance of the outside of the school building (e.g., windows, roof, etc.). In order to be proactive, we decided to set aside the monies that are received in the second collection school envelope for future maintenance and/or capital repairs on the school building. The envelope generates about \$1,900 per collection. In the course of a year, there are ten School Support envelopes. The estimated income from this collection could be about \$ 19,000. As always, we are grateful for your collaboration in our many Church ministries. May God continue to bless you! — Bishop Sanchez

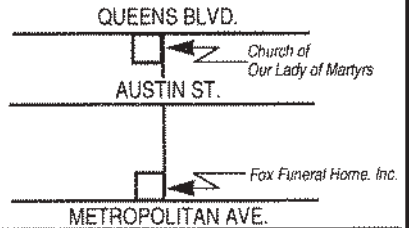
