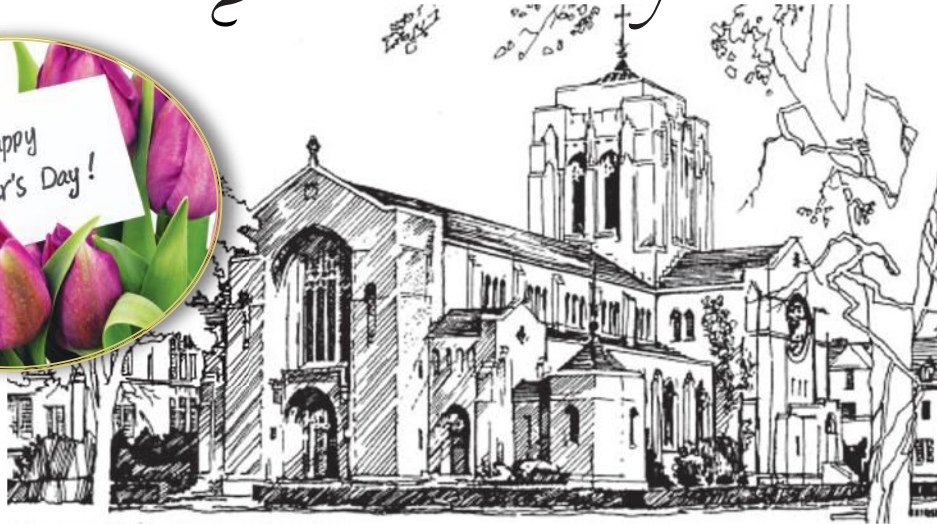

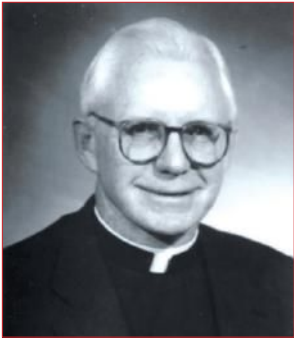

Remembering “Father Bill” Galvin (1929 – 2016)

To those of us in Forest Hills in the 1930s and 1940s, he was Billy Galvin. A happy and familiar presence at OLQM church and grammar school (class of 1943) and then Bishop Loughlin HS in Brooklyn, he was drawn to foreign missionary work. Ordained a Maryknoll priest on June 9, 1956, Fr. Bill’s spiritual sojourn took him all over the world: Hawaii, the Philippines, Israel, Nepal, India and, through various Maryknoll leadership positions, ultimately Hong Kong and mainland China. The Maryknoll High School of Cateel, Philippines, that he built was destroyed in a 2013 typhoon, but he was organizing its rebuilding and it will be a memorial to his life’s work. Clarification on School/Academy Support Second Collection Envelopes

The Parish Finance Committee recommends that we clarify the purpose of the periodic second collection envelope currently marked “School Support.” Bishop DiMarzio has mandated that all parish Catholic elementary schools become academies. Our Lady Queen of Martyrs School officially became an academy in September 2015. With that change, a Board of Members was seated composed of Bishops Massa and Sanchez, Father Passenant, Superintendent Thomas Chadzutko, and Deputy Superintendents Anthony Biscione and Brother Ralph Darmento, FSC. A Board of Directors was also seated composed of generous and dedicated volunteers who meet monthly to assist Principal Anne Zuschlag with the running of the school.

Our Lady Queen of Martyrs parish remains responsible for the maintenance of the outside of the school building (e.g., windows, roof, etc.). We have decided to proactively set aside the monies that are received in the second collection school envelope for future maintenance and/or capital repairs on the school building. The envelope generates about \$1,900 per collection. In the course of a year, there are ten School Support envelopes. The estimated income from this collection could be about \$ 19,000.

Beginning 2017 those envelopes will be labeled “Academy Support” and will serve the same purpose.

As always, we are grateful for your collaboration in our many Church ministries. May God continue to bless you!

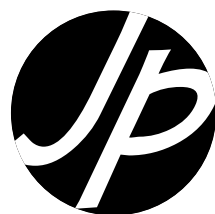

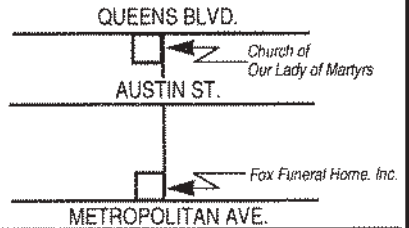
