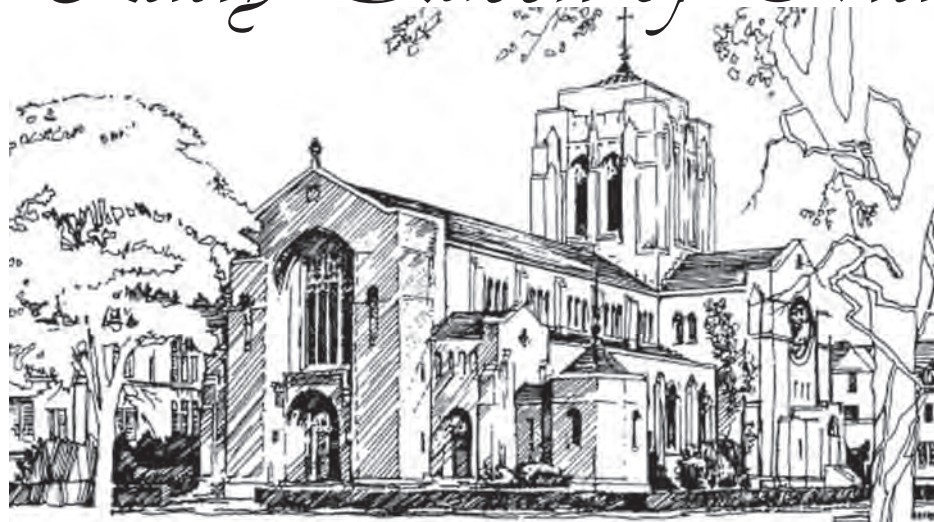

Month of Mary

Report from Lourdes

The Grotto in Lourdes, France, is where St. Bernadette saw the Mary apparitions in 1858. Mary instructed Bernadette to tell the faithful to make a pilgrimage to Lourdes. Since then, countless pilgrims from around the world visit the Grotto each year, making Lourdes the second most visited city in France behind Paris.

More than 700 handwritten prayer requests from OLQM parishioners were personally delivered, on your behalf, to this famous Grotto of miracles by Roger Aguinaldo and his wife Ruby. They joined a Lourdes pilgrimage, from April 29 to May 5, with the Knights and Dames of Malta. Cardinal Timothy Dolan and Bishop Frank Caggiano of the Diocese of Bridgeport (formerly Auxiliary Bishop of Brooklyn) were spiritual leaders.



At the famed and sacred site where the Blessed Mother appeared—1) Cardinal Dolan celebrated Mass in the Grotto of apparitions. 2) Devotional candles burn day and night in a large candle stand in front of a statue of Our Lady of Lourdes. 3) Roger placing the petitions in the safe slot at the Grotto; petitions are to be read and prayed by the Sisters-followers of St. Bernadette. 4) Your petitions arranged next to the Grotto stream. 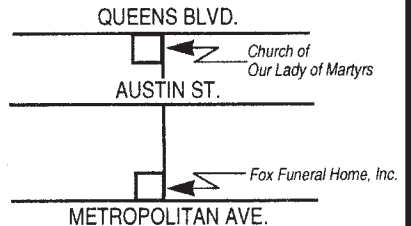
