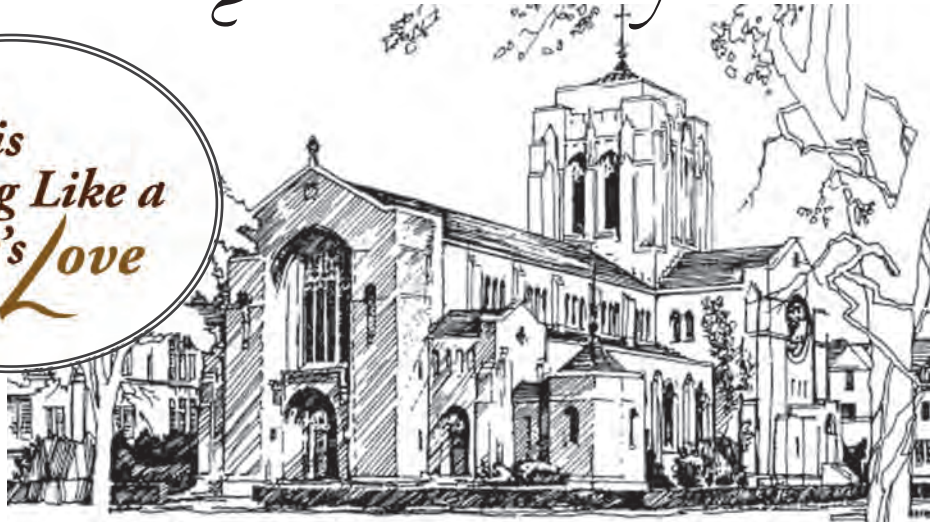

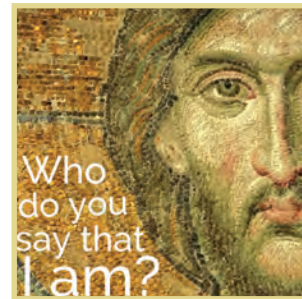

During This Year of Mercy

Deacon Greg at the Jubilee for Deacons

Last month Deacon Greg Kandra was invited by the Vatican to address the English-speaking deacons during the Jubilee for Deacons, which was celebrated May 27-29 to promote the role of the deacon as dispenser of charity. He delivered his talk on “The Deacon as Image of Mercy in the Workplace” at the Basilica of Santa Maria sopra Minerva in Rome. Then on Sunday, May 29, he joined over 3,000 deacons and their wives from around the world for the Mass celebrated in St. Peter’s Square by Pope Francis. Greg and his wife Siobhan were among a small group invited to meet the Holy Father after Mass. “It was truly the trip of a lifetime,” Greg says. 

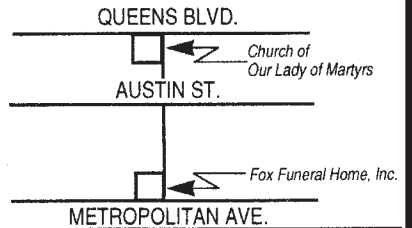
