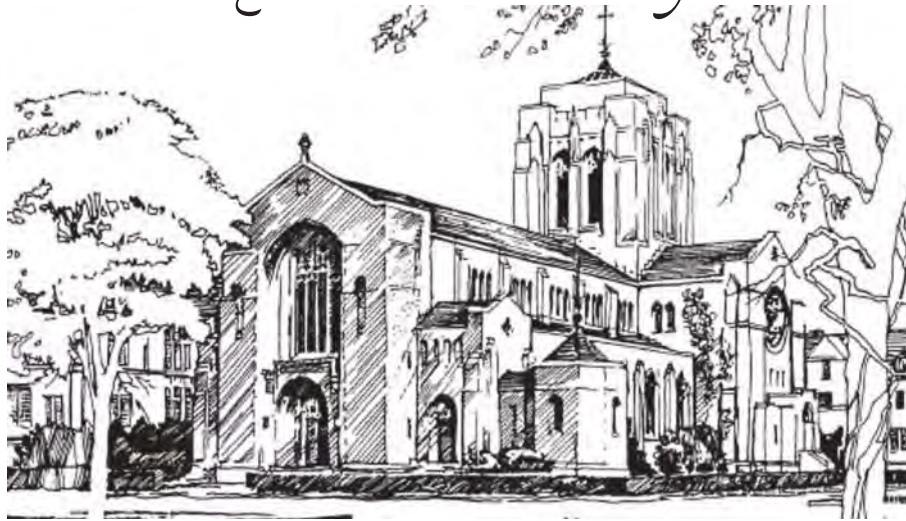

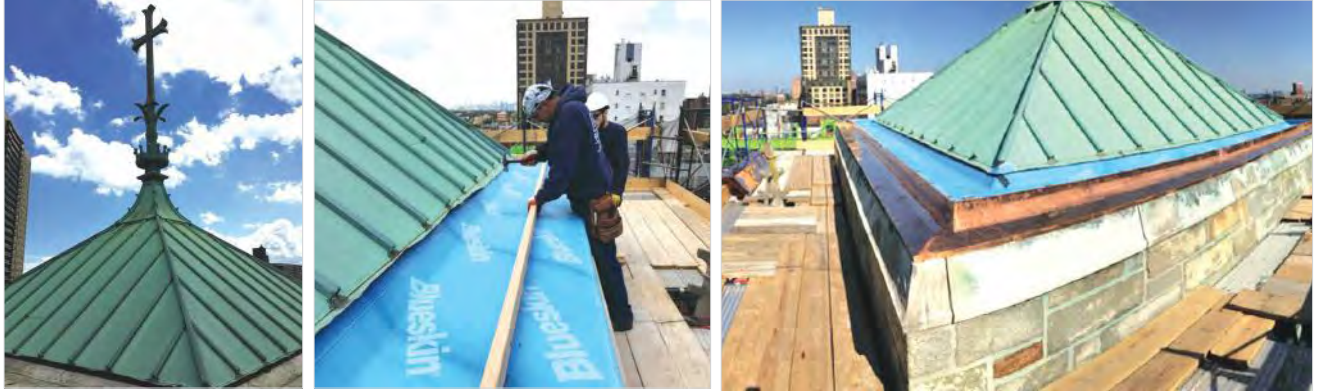

REPAIR ■ MAINTENANCE ■ PRESERVATION

Repair of the Church Bell Tower Roof



One of the most recognizable features of our church building is the bell tower, designed in the neo-Gothic style and topped with a cross on a pyramidal copper roof. The roof's original gutters and drainage works are no longer sufficient to prevent leaking and erosion of the masonry by rain and are being repaired to prevent further deterioration from water damage inside the bell tower. The work on the bell tower roof and the drain/plumbing inside the tower is being documented in a full series of pictures available on our website at ourladyqueenofmartyrs.org/bell-tower.

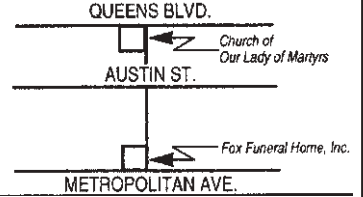
