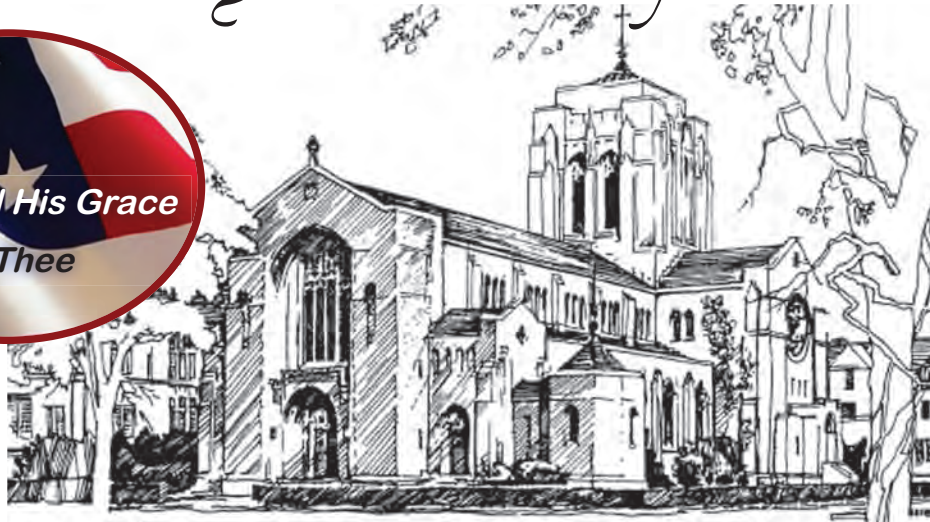

Thomas Jorge Moves Closer to Ordination

Twelve deacon candidates in the Brooklyn Diocese took the final step toward ordination on June 22, as they were admitted to the ministry of acolyte. I'm pleased and proud to say that one of those twelve is Thomas Jorge, from Our Lady Queen of Martyrs. Tom's wife, Olga, along with friends and family members, were in attendance, offering their prayerful support. The installation Mass was celebrated at Immaculate Conception Center in Douglaston by Auxiliary Bishop James Massa, with Bishop Paul Sanchez concelebrating.

As described in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the ministry of the acolyte "is instituted for service at the altar and to assist the Priest and Deacon. It is his place

principally to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels and, if necessary, to distribute the Eucharist to the faithful as an extraordinary minister." Outside

of Mass, the acolyte may also expose the Blessed Sacrament for Adoration—moving it from the tabernacle to the monstrance—and return the Sacrament to the tabernacle afterward.

During Mass, Bishop Massa presented each deacon candidate with the sacred vessels and said, "Take this vessel with bread for the celebration of the Eucharist. Make your life worthy of your service at the table of the Lord and of his Church."

As Tom becomes more involved in the liturgical life and ministry of the parish, please join me in praying for him and his brother deacon candidates—and their wives!—as their formation continues. By the grace of God, Tom will be ordained to Holy Orders on May 27, 2017.



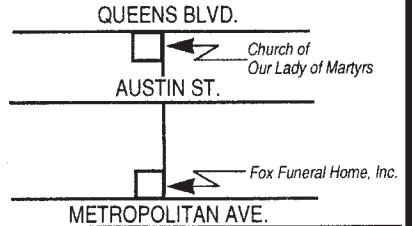
