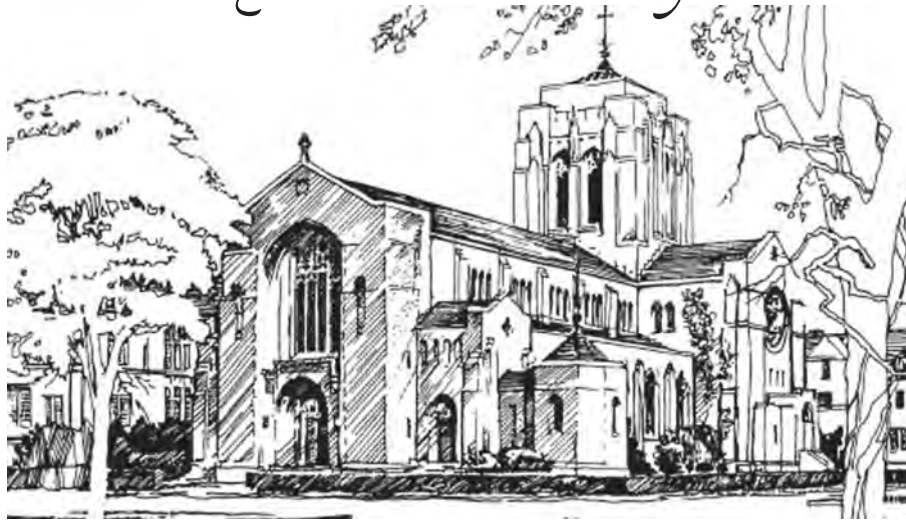

Bereavement Support Is Available

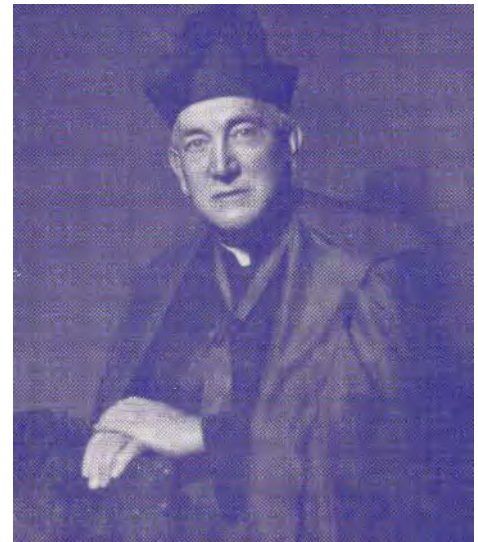

1917-2017: Centennial of Our Founding Pastor

This is the first in a series of articles on the legacy of Monsignor Joseph R. McLaughlin, the man who built our parish Church, school, rectory and convent buildings.

From 1912 to 1917, OLQM was a mission of Holy Child Jesus parish, Richmond Hill. Then, on September 15, 1917 (Our Lady of Sorrows), Father McLaughlin was appointed first resident pastor—although he actually first resided at the Forest Hills Inn briefly before moving to the residence made available in the back of the original wooden church. The present-day church and rectory buildings were still just a dream and would take two decades to materialize under McLaughlin’s leadership.

Father McLaughlin (later Monsignor) believed in “the march of progress,” according to a local newspaper, and wanted the young parish to “keep pace with the development of this community [of Forest Hills], so that the church will always be able to perform its function for the spiritual, moral and cultural well-being of the community.” Over 10 years (1917–1927), he negotiated for the purchase of land for the development of our parish’s church complex, sketching the ground plans for a unified group of parish buildings spanning one full block in the middle of what was then Queens farmland.

The architectural firm Monsignor McLaughlin selected, Maginnis and Walsh, was known for its Gothic revival design of churches in Boston and was also the designer of Regis High School in Manhattan and the renovated Lady Chapel altar inside St. Patrick’s Cathedral. The first new building constructed under McLaughlin’s parish plan was the school. He invited the Sisters Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, all graduates of Marywood College in Scranton, Pennsylvania, to staff the new parish school that opened its doors in 1928. The school building was awarded first prize by the Queensborough Chamber of Commerce “for excellence in design and civic value.”

After a fire made regular use of the original wooden church unusable, Monsignor McLaughlin commissioned a plain oak altar and reredos screen that the architects installed in the school’s assembly hall, which served as church until the new church and rectory were constructed a decade later in 1939; a new convent building was dedicated in 1956.

Father McLaughlin led the parish planning from vision to fruition—and yet we think he would remind us, too, not to obsess over these achievements and remember that Christ is the true “head builder” and cornerstone of our Church.

Then and Now

The school building was completed in 1928. The building follows the decorated English Gothic revival style and is constructed of Weymouth Seam-Face Granite of varied tone with Indiana Limestone trimming. The spectacular spire symbolizes heavenly aspirations and today remains one of the most recognizable features of the Forest Hills landscape.

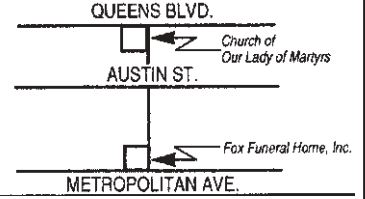
