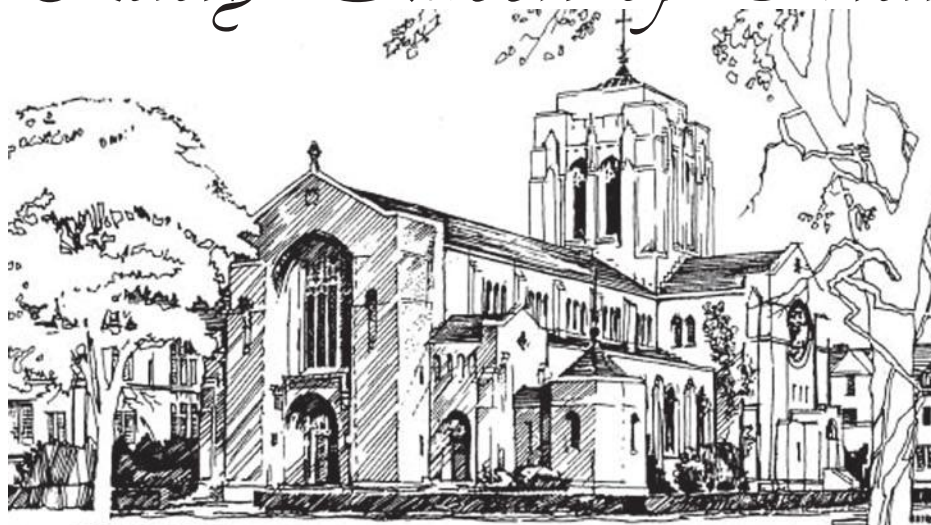

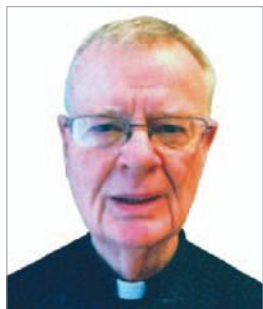
Andrew Avellino (Flushing). After the 11:30 Mass, there will be an opportunity to receive a “First Blessing” from Father Osorio.

Father Gildea also served as pastor at Our Lady of Loreto, East New York (1986-89) and Holy Family 14th St., Park Slope (1989-95). Among his other

assignments, he was a member of the diocesan mission in San Isidro, Dominican Republic from 1995 to 1998; earlier his missionary work took him to Paraguay in the 1970s and 1980s. His first assignment after leaving Christ the King Seminary (Olean, NY) was as an assistant at St. Matthew, East New York (1966-69).

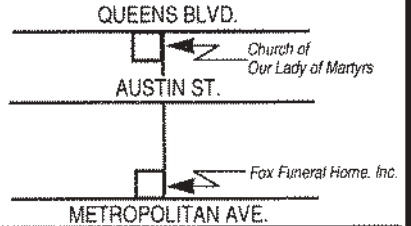
