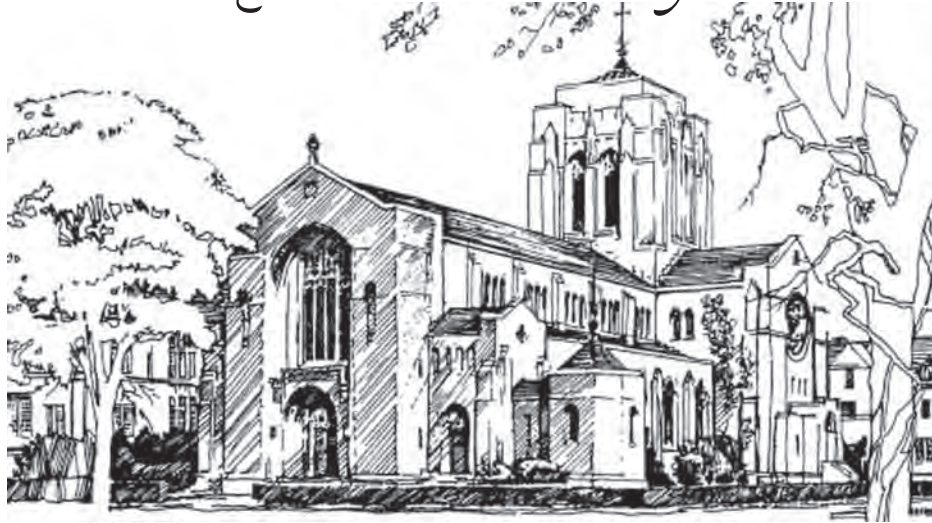

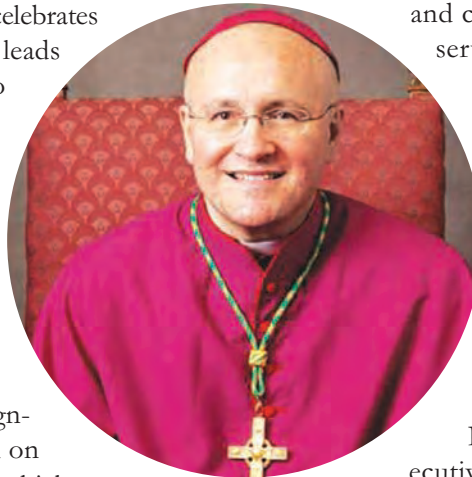

WELCOME TO NEWLY ORDAINED BISHOP, MOST REV. JAMES MASSA

Today we greet The Most Rev. James Massa with a warm welcome as he celebrates the 11:30 a.m. Mass with us and leads us in day seven of our novena to Saint John Vianney.

In some small way Our Lady Queen of Martyrs parish helped to foster this newest bishop for the Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens. Bishop Massa was ordained as a priest of this diocese on October 25, 1986, and he began his first assignment a month later at our parish on November 23. He served as parochial vicar here at OLQM for four years. As some of you may remember, he implemented the first RCIA course at our parish and was instrumental in growing our Religious Education and altar server programs.



Teaching is one of Bishop Massa's special gifts and calling. He left OLQM in 1990 to serve as campus minister at Queens College, caring for the spiritual needs of Catholic students. Later, he held positions at seminaries and universities as an associate professor of theology, including on the faculty of Blessed John XXIII National Seminary (Weston, MA) and the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception (Huntington, NY). In 2005, he was named Executive Director of the Secretariat for Ecumenical and Interreligious Dialogue for the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington, DC, and in 2008, Pope Benedict XVI appointed Father Massa Consulter to the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue.

He returned to Brooklyn in 2011 to become Coordinator for a partnership between the Archdiocese of New York, the Diocese of Rockville Centre, and the Diocese of Brooklyn to prepare Catholic leaders for service in the spirit of the New Evangelization. Since 2014, he has also served as the Moderator of the Curia in the Brooklyn Diocese. Bishop Massa holds a bachelor's in theology and history from Boston College, a master's of divinity from Yale, and a PhD in systematic theology from Fordham.

Today, let us all thank God for Bishop Massa's past service to this parish community and his work teaching thousands of Catholic students and seminarians over the years. We offer our prayerful best wishes that he may have many years of success in his new assignment as an auxiliary bishop of the Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens.

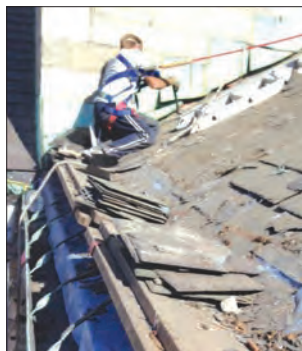
Your Generous Gifts at Work: Church Roof Repair Underway

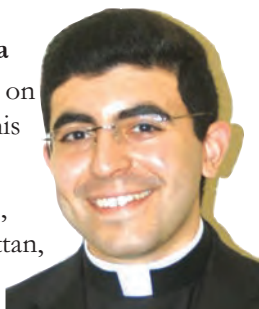

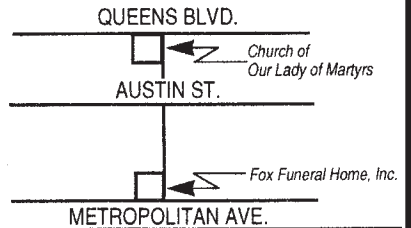
