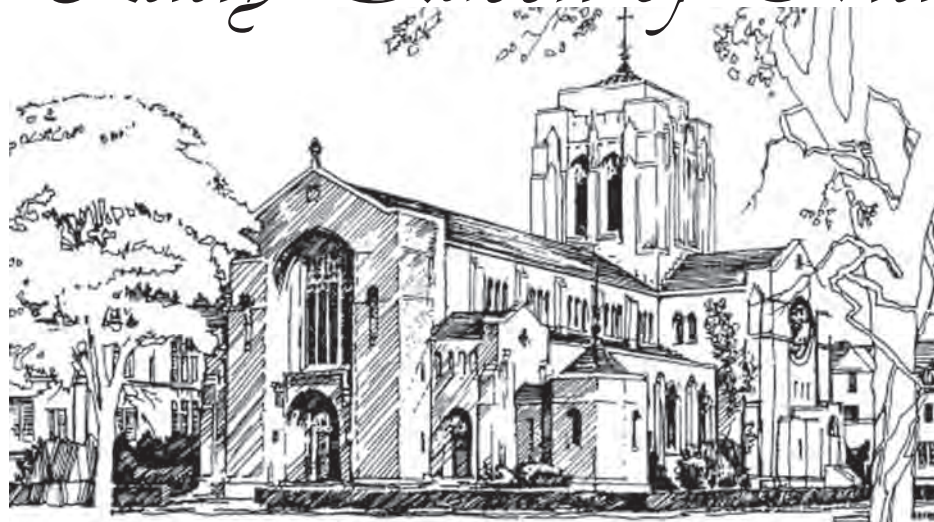

Status of Parish Capital Campaign

The letter below has been reviewed by the members of the Parish Finance Committee and was sent to all those who have contributed or are contributing to the campaign. It summarizes how the campaign funds have been spent so far. It also explains how some of the remaining funds will be used. God bless all who have made this possible!

Dear Faithful Donor,

Please accept our sincere gratitude for your continued generosity to the Parish Capital Campaign. To date, the following renovations have been accomplished because of your collaboration:

- The lighting in the Church has been upgraded.
- Stained glass windows have been repaired and the protective glass on those windows has been replaced where necessary.
- The school auditorium has been made accessible.
- Some of the smaller Church roofs have been replaced.

The original campaign brochure recommended re-pointing the parish building surfaces. In studying our needs more closely, we realize that the more immediate need is to repair the larger sections of the upper and lower Church roofs where there are signs that water is penetrating. It is for that reason that you will now see work being done on the lower sections of the Church roof on the school side and the Queens Boulevard side.

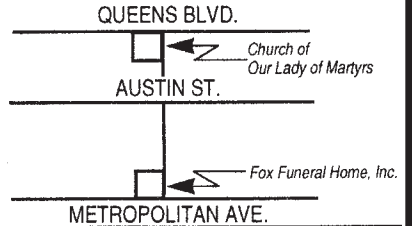
