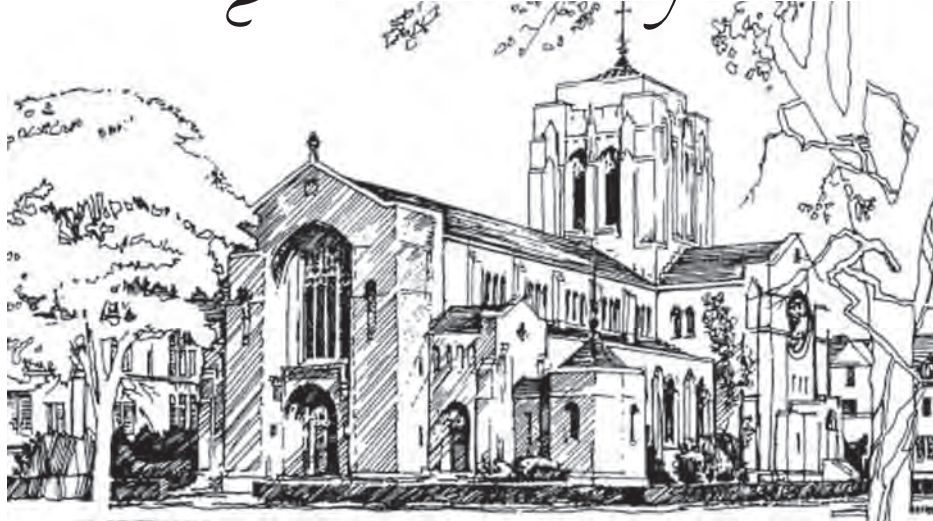

IN SOLIDARITY WITH PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS IN THE MIDDLE EAST

The plight of Christians worldwide, especially in the Middle East, has become a major catastrophe. Massive numbers of Christians are being subjected to violence, displacement and even death, explicitly because of their faith. The West is paying little attention and few governments are saying anything in response. However far away, we are impacted by the sufferings of our fellow Christians; we are all one human family. Sisters of Charity-Halifax — Part of Our History

Wherever you find a Sister of Charity-Halifax, you'll find a woman fulfilling her mission to "give joyful witness to love: the love of God, of one another, and of all persons."

Sisters of Charity have a long and strong history in education, since their founding by Elizabeth Ann Seton two centuries ago. Eventually four Sisters of Charity from New York were called to Halifax, Nova Scotia, to serve as teachers in the first religious community in that maritime city. Within a few years there were enough Halifax Sisters to establish a new congregation, separate from the New York branch.

Their mission was most successful: the Sisters educated the poor, educated girls from all stations of life, and cared for orphans and the sick.

Respected and sought after in their various works, the Sisters were called back to service in New York in the 1920s, by Monsignor Joseph McClancy of Brooklyn, where teaching was the preeminent mission. Here in Queens, they founded and originally staffed the parish schools of St. Nicholas of Tolentine in Jamaica and Resurrection-Ascension in Rego Park, among a dozen other schools in New York and New Jersey.

Today, more than 350 Sisters of Charity-Halifax serve in five countries. They work in the spirit of Saints Elizabeth Seton, Vincent de Paul, and Louise de Marillac, addressing the needs of the poor and providing spiritual direction, pastoral ministry, and healthcare, and education services.

Last year, the Sisters celebrated 90 years of service in the New York area. Sixty-five Sisters serve in the metropolitan area—and we are honored to have five Sisters living here at the convent of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs.

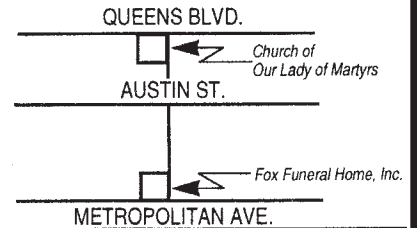
