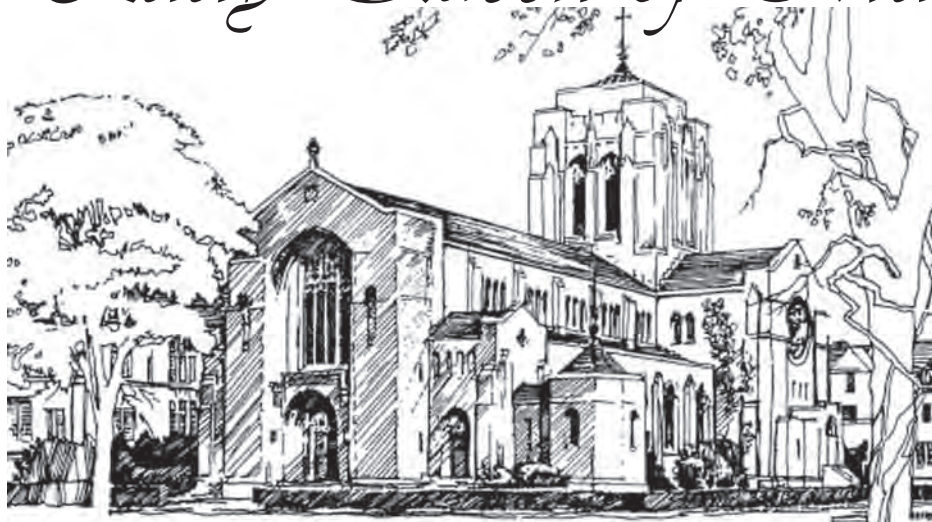

The Sisters of Charity-Halifax from our convent—Sisters Elizabeth Bickar, Carol Buckley, Susan Dean, Frances Gritte, and Maureen Murphy—will be our honorees at the special 11:30 sung Mass. Sisters of Charity were founded by Elizabeth Seton, and this September 14 also marks 40 years since Mother Seton's canonization as the first American saint. Sisters of Charity-Halifax: Part of Queens History

Sisters of Charity-Halifax live their mission to “give joyful witness to love: the love of God, of one another, and of all persons.”

Sisters of Charity have a long and strong history in education since their founding by Elizabeth Ann Seton two centuries ago. Eventually four Sisters from New York were called to Halifax, Nova Scotia, to serve as teachers. Their mission was most successful: the Sisters educated the poor and girls from all stations of life; they cared for orphans and the sick; and, within a few years, there were enough Halifax Sisters to establish a new congregation, separate from the New York branch.

Respected and sought after in their various works, the Sisters were called back to service in New York in the 1920s by Monsignor Joseph McClancy, the superintendent of Catholic schools in the Diocese of Brooklyn, where teaching was the preeminent mission. **(See the sidebar box for related history.)**

Here in Queens, Sisters of Charity-Halifax originally staffed the parish schools of St. Nicholas of Tolentine in Jamaica and Resurrection-Ascension in Rego Park, among a dozen other schools in New York and New Jersey.

More than 350 Sisters of Charity-Halifax now serve in five countries. They work in the spirit of Saints Elizabeth Seton, Vincent de Paul, and Louise de Marillac, addressing the needs of the poor and providing spiritual direction, pastoral ministry, and healthcare and education services.

Last year, the Sisters celebrated 90 years of service in New York. There are 65 Sisters in the metro area—and we are honored to have five Sisters living here at the convent of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs.

Remembering the IHM Sisters of Our Parish Past

Monsignor McClancy of Brooklyn also arranged for another congregation of religious women—six Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM)—to staff Father Joseph McLaughlin’s brand-new school at Forest Hills, in 1928. The Sisters of IHM were known to be spiritual and cultured women, and highly qualified teachers. Their goodness and dedication brought many blessings to Our Lady Queen of Martyrs for many years. Today, the IHM congregation continues to sponsor educational facilities in Scranton, PA.

IN SOLIDARITY WITH PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS IN THE MIDDLE EAST

The plight of Christians worldwide, especially in the Middle East, has become a major catastrophe. Massive numbers of Christians are being subjected to violence, displacement and even death, explicitly because of their faith. However far away, we are impacted by the sufferings of our fellow Christians; we are all one human family. Catholic social teaching calls us to stand in solidarity. 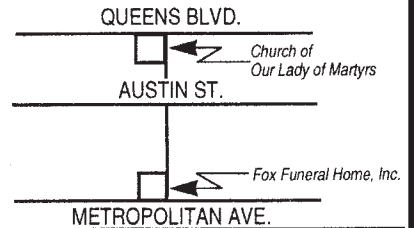
