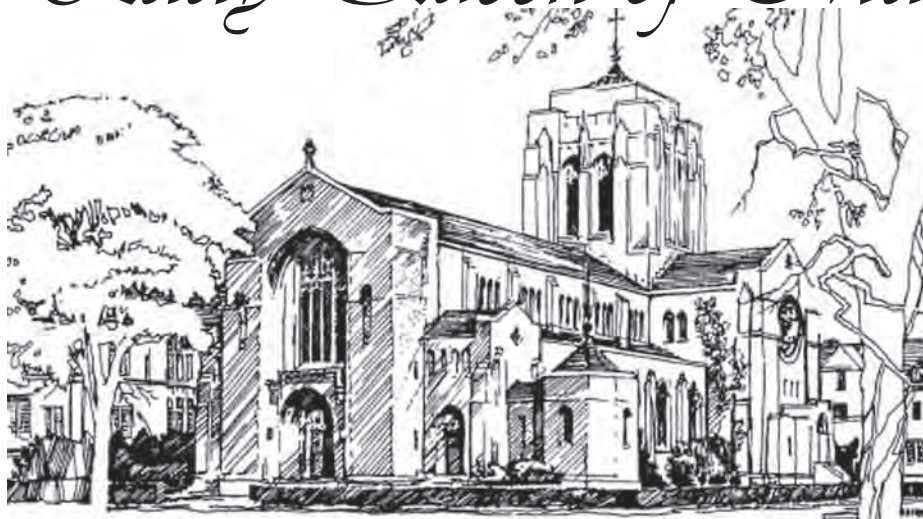

MASS IN HONOR OF KOREAN MARTYRS

Holy Martyr Andrew Kim Taegon, the first Korean Catholic priest, is venerated as Korea's Patron Saint. He and 102 others, including Paul Chong Hasang, were canonized in 1984 by Saint Pope John Paul II. In 2014, Pope Francis beatified Paul Yun Ji-chung and his 123 companions. Collectively, both groups are known as the "Korean Martyrs."

The Korean Martyrs knew the cost of discipleship and willingly made great sacrifices. Everyone is invited to join this Mass to honor them. We'll have refreshments afterward in the rectory basement.

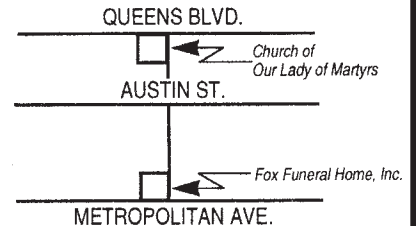
