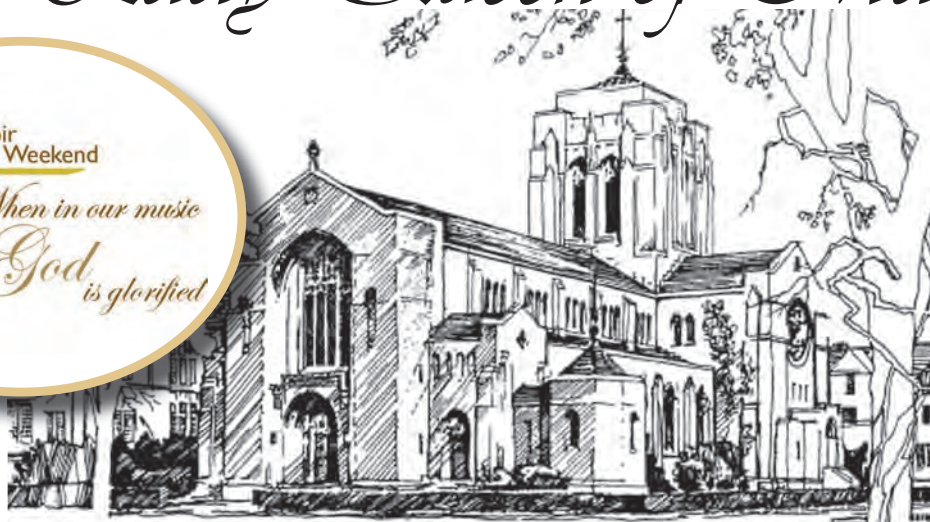

Curia) are the prime sponsors of the Academy, appointing the lay Board of Directors and ensuring the overall Catholic identity of the Academy and its programs. The Board of Directors is the Academy's governing body, overseeing specific committees such as finance, institutional advancement, student life, and facilities. Directors were chosen for their varied skill sets, experience base, world connections, and parish knowledge. Our directors are Mark Scapp, Chairman; Denise De Maria, Vice Chair; Kevin Hogan, Treasurer; Marylou Curcio Szabo, Secretary; Margaret Byrnes, John Davi, Robert Johnson, Craig Katinas, and Paula Walker. They work closely with Principal Anne Zuschlag, who remains the instructional, educational, and spiritual leader of the Academy.

On his role as Academy Chairman, Mark Scapp says his responsibilities include the "duty of care—in making decisions, demonstrating diligence and skill—and duty of obedience, [being] faithful to the mission of Catholic education." He adds that "for the Academy process to be fully successful and for the Board to carry out its fiduciary responsibilities, we need to have trust, especially with regard to the relationship between a Director and the Academy and its stakeholders."

Principal Anne Zuschlag reiterates. "The OLQM community is excited to begin a new phase under the guidance of a Board of Directors. Each of these individuals has pledged to dedicate countless hours in support of Catholic education," she says, adding, "The partnership with our school families, staff, and parish has already begun."

Bishop Sanchez is bestowing a special blessing on the Board of Directors at the 5 p.m. Mass on October 17. "We are grateful to a group of individuals who voluntarily serve on the Board of Directors of our new Academy," he says. "They are giving of their time and talent to assist the Principal in the running of the Academy. We look forward to working together to continue to enable OLQM Catholic Academy to thrive as a Catholic community of quality education."

The other key partners in the governance model are the parents, who support and enrich the endeavors of the Academy. The Board encourages members of the Home Academy Association to join the various committees to lend their skills to the ongoing successful operation of OLQM. Enrollment, financials, and test scores remain strong, and the Board is committed to continuing the wonderful legacy of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs education.†

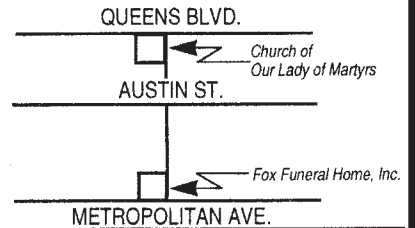
