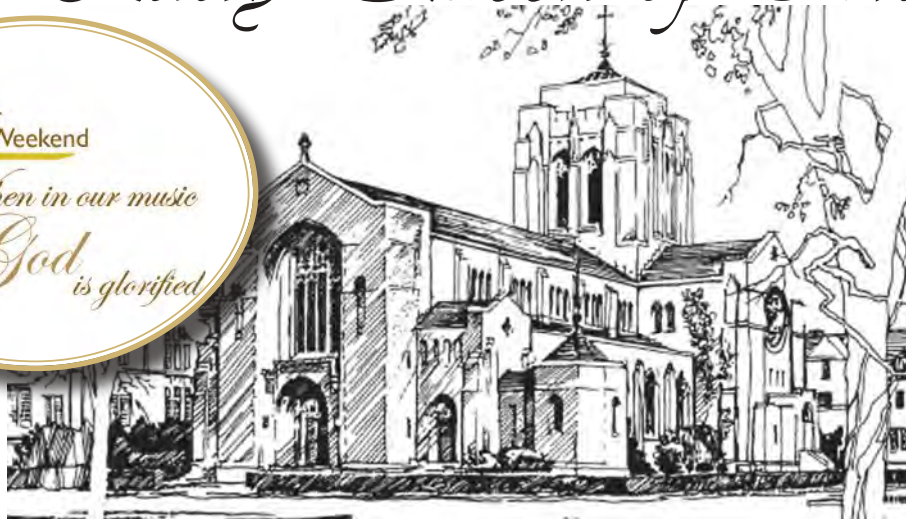

Special All Souls Remembrances for the Month of November

In the Apostles Creed we pray: “I believe in the communion of saints.” The word *communion* means a “sharing” and also “communication.” The word *saints* in the Creed does not just mean the saints in heaven. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us (paragraph 946), it “includes people who have died, but have gone to purgatory and that includes the people who are still alive.” It includes us! We are trying to become saints and we are already part of the communion of saints.

The Church has terms that identify the three different groups of souls who are part of the communion of saints. Those who are already in heaven are the *Church triumphant*. Those who are waiting in purgatory are called the *Church suffering*, and we who are still alive on earth are called the *Church militant*.

At Our Lady Queen of Martyrs we try in our special way during the year, and especially in November, to remember the souls of our faithfully departed brothers and sisters whose funerals were celebrated here. We will be remembering our dearly departed brothers and sisters who we buried here during the last five years through a reading of their names in alphabetical order at the Masses starting on November 2.

Active members of our church community through their annual almsgiving remember the souls of their loved ones through their participation in the memorial candles at the Sacred Heart of Jesus altar. Then and Now at OLQM

History of the Parish Gala

From the church bulletin archives: One of the first “Get-Togethers” for our parish was a Card Party and Dance on January 26, 1932, in the school auditorium, under the auspices of the OLQM Social and Dramatic Society. In later years the Parish Card Party was moved off-site to the Lost Battalion Building. Writing about one of these occasions in *The Parish Monthly*, Father Joseph McLaughlin said it “was a most heartening evidence of parish unity and solidarity . . . all the proof that anyone could ask of the devotion of our people to their parish. . . . All who attended had a most enjoyable evening and were unanimous in expressing the hope that the ‘Get-Together’ would become an annual affair.”

Today: The Lost Battalion Building on Queens Blvd., Rego Park, once a hall for the American Legion, is now a community center. And the parish “Get-Together” has evolved into the annual Parish Gala Dinner-Dance. The 2017 Gala is Wednesday, November 8, starting at 6 p.m., at Russo’s on the Bay in Howard Beach.

Let’s all honor Father McLaughlin, this centennial year of his appointment as our first pastor, by coming together on November 8 and giving evidence to our parish unity and solidarity!

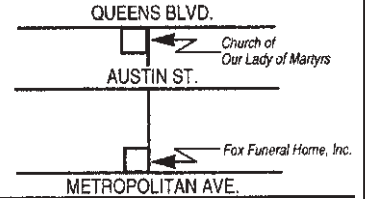
