November is customarily a time to visit the graves of loved ones and pray for them at the site of their resting place. The Catholic Cemeteries office can assist in choosing a gravesite or crypt where you would like to be buried. Contact them at 718-894-4888 or www.ccbklyn.org.

It is also time to remember that the cremains (ashes) of our loved ones deserve a final resting place. The Church instructs that cremated remains of a body should be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they come. This includes the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried, and the care and attention given to appropriate placement and transport and final disposition. Cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home, are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.


