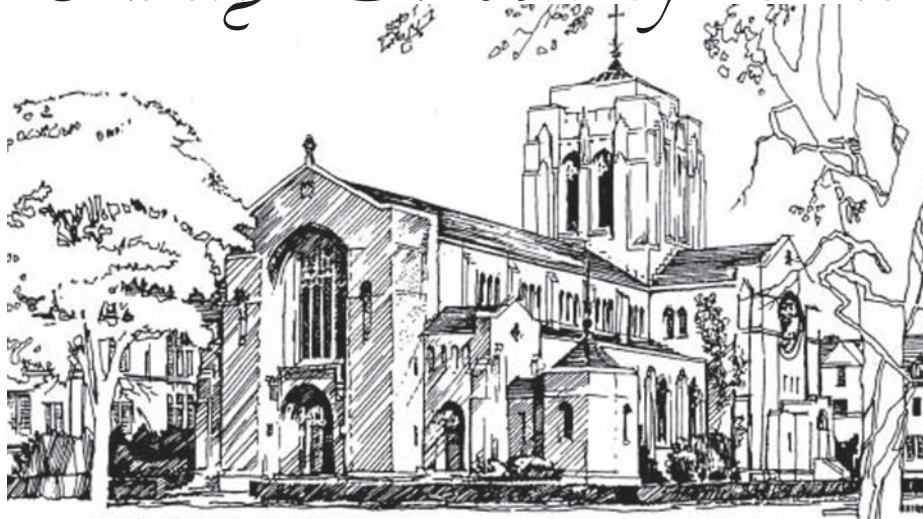

I'm pleased and proud to serve as Tom's mentor during his formation—and delighted to announce another milestone in his studies: On October 30, Thomas took another step closer to ordination when he was formally instituted into the Ministry of Lector in a Mass celebrated by Bishop Raymond Chappetto at the Immaculate Conception Center in Douglaston.

In formation for Holy Orders, whether it's to the priesthood or the diaconate, there are three distinct levels—Candidacy, Lector, and Acolyte—followed by Ordination. Tom's class is expected to be admitted to the Ministry of Acolyte next year and ordained in May or June 2017.

Prayers for the Faithful Departed

During November we remember those who have gone before us in faith. At this time, we pray for our own beloved family members who have died and remember those who have no one to pray for them.

November is also a time to visit the graves of our loved ones and pray for them at the site of their resting place. The office of Catholic Cemeteries encourages each of us to pre-plan our own funeral and can assist in choosing a gravesite or crypt where we would like to be buried. You can contact Catholic Cemeteries by calling **718-894-4888** or going to www.ccbklyn.org.

November is also a time to remember that the remains of our loved ones deserve a final resting place. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) advises that cremated remains of a body should be treated with the

same respect given to the human body from which they come—from the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried, the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition.

Cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased, are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.

Let eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace; may they and all the faithful departed, rest in peace. Amen.

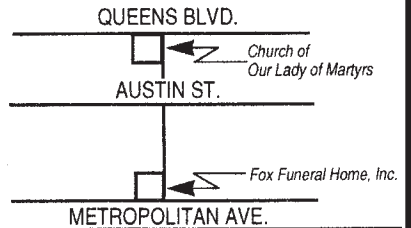
