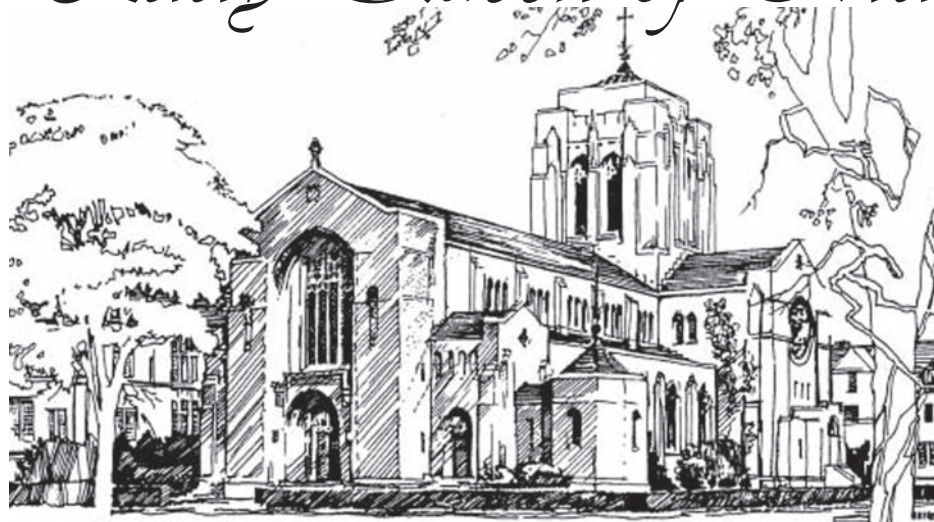

Parish Thanksgiving Canned Food Drive

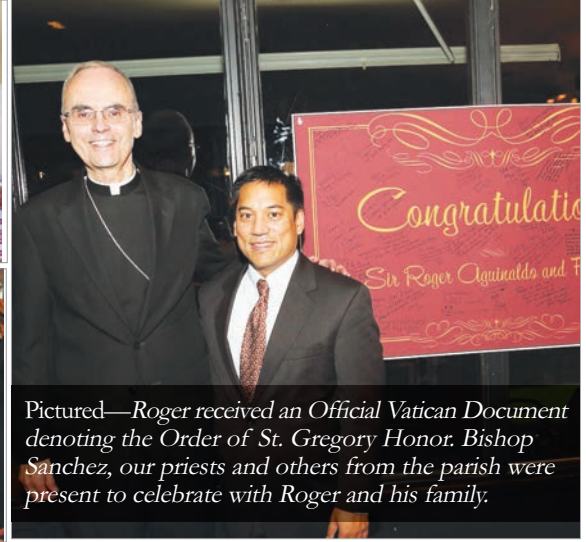

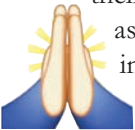

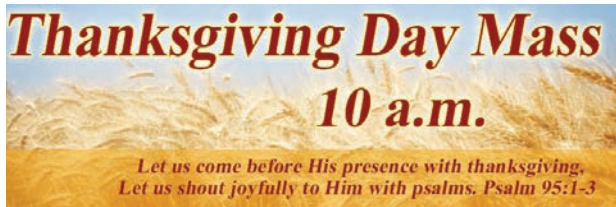

Prayers for the Faithful Departed

Cremated Remains

November is also a time to remember that the cremains of our loved ones deserve a final resting place. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) advises that cremated remains of a body

should be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they come—from the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried, the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition.

Cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased, are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.

Let eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace; may they and all the faithful departed, rest in peace. Amen.

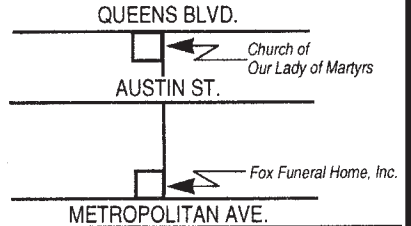
