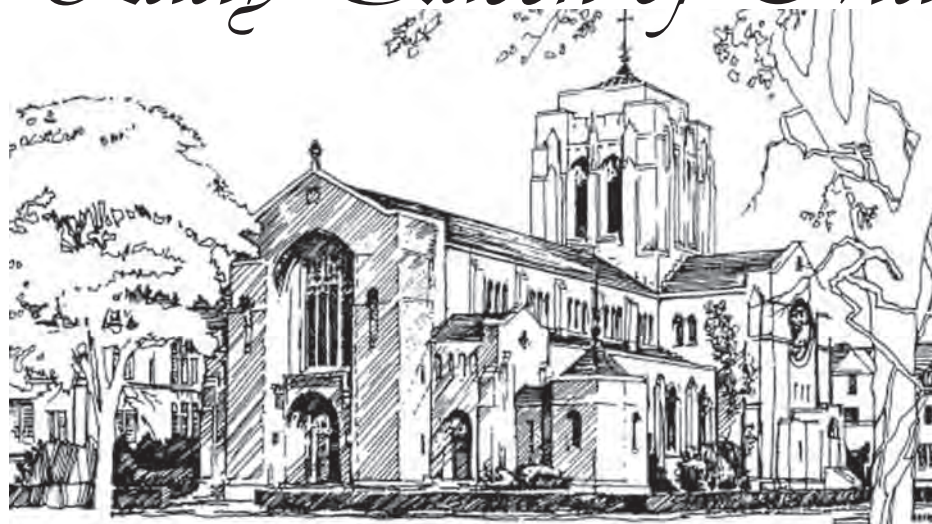

Census Sunday 2014 Results

Our Lady Queen of Martyrs conducted a Census on September 13 and 14, in an effort to increase parish registration and update current parishioner information. *Parish registration is the best way to certify parish membership.* Registering at OLQM is a declaration of one's desire to be a part of our Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of our parish.

More than 800 parishioners completed a registration form. Here are some of the tabulated results.

- Many of our survey participants (over 29%) were not officially registered with our parish.
- The parish's cultural and lingual composition remains as diverse as ever (note that a participant could choose more than one race or language). *It is this diversity that enables OLQM to continue having several special ethnic celebrations every year.*
- Of participants who indicated that OLQM is their parish, 29% started worshipping here within the last five years, and 23% of OLQM's parishioners have lived in the neighborhood no more than five years. *So, as the parish changes, pastoral needs are changing as well.*

Prayers for the Faithful Departed

November is the month when we remember those who have gone before us in faith. At this time, we pray for our own beloved family members who have died and remember those who have no one to pray for them.

November is also a time to visit the graves of our loved ones and pray for them at the site of their resting place. The Catholic Cemeteries office encourages each of us to pre-plan our own funeral, and the office can assist us in choosing a grave site or crypt where we would like to be buried. November is also a time to remember that the cremains of our loved ones deserve a final resting place. The United States Bishops offer the following advice:

The cremated remains of a body should be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they come. This includes the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried and the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition. The cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.

Let eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace; may they and all the faithful departed, rest in peace. Amen.

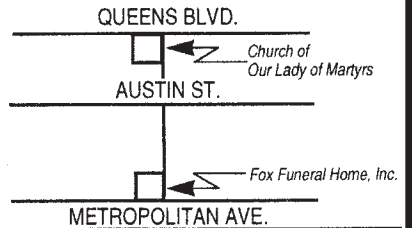
